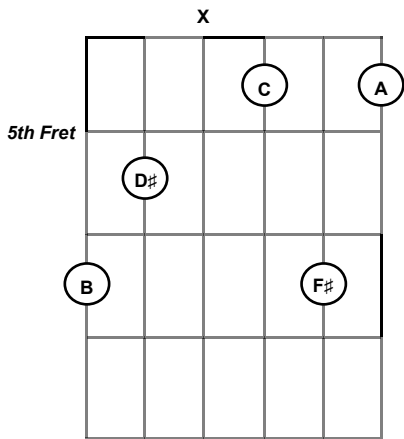


The A7<sup>b</sup>9 chord can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret. It is played without the 4th string. This is represented by "X". When we slide the A7<sup>b</sup>9 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

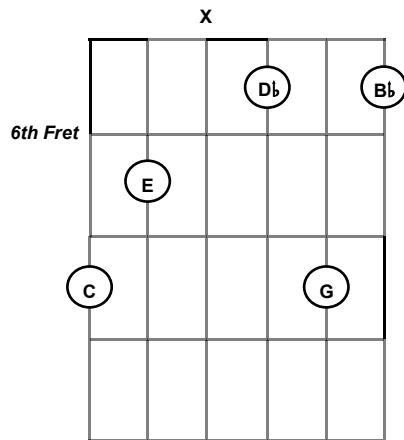
**B7<sup>b</sup>9**

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



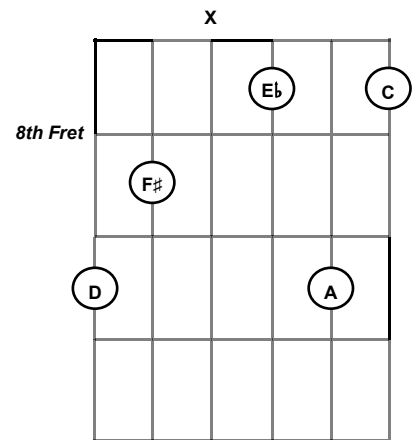
**C7<sup>b</sup>9**

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.



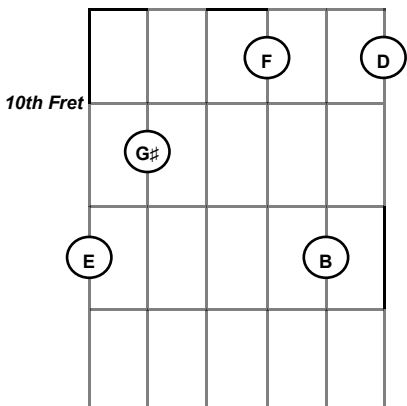
**D7<sup>b</sup>9**

Can be played on either the 8th or 20th fret.



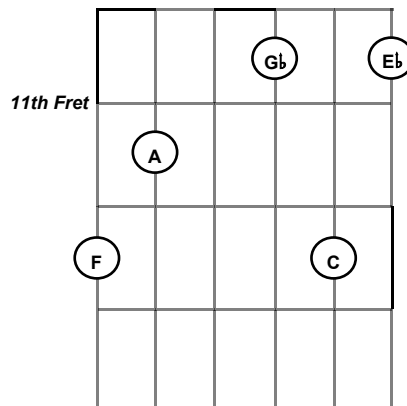
