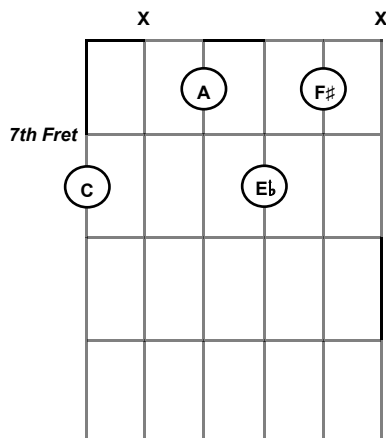


The C7 $\flat$ 9 chord can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret. It is played without the 1st and 5th strings. This is represented by "X." When we slide the C7 $\flat$ 9 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

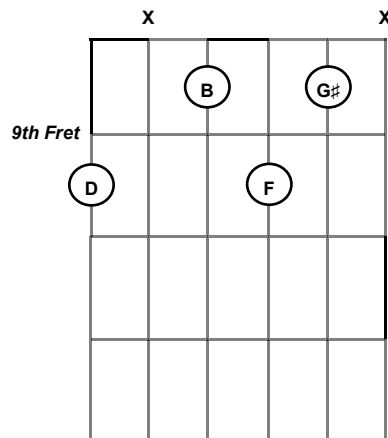
### D7 $\flat$ 9

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.



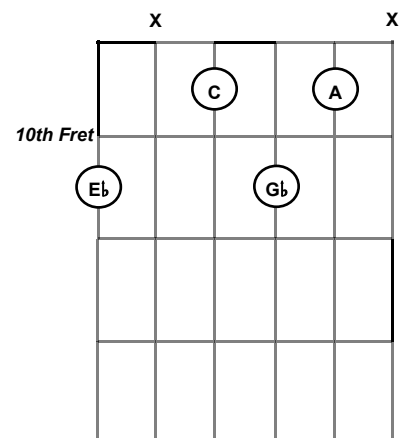
### E7 $\flat$ 9

Can be played on either the 9th or 21st fret.

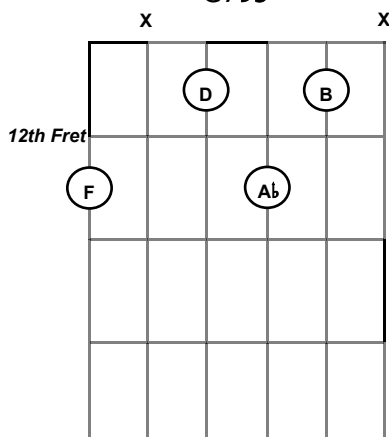


### F7 $\flat$ 9

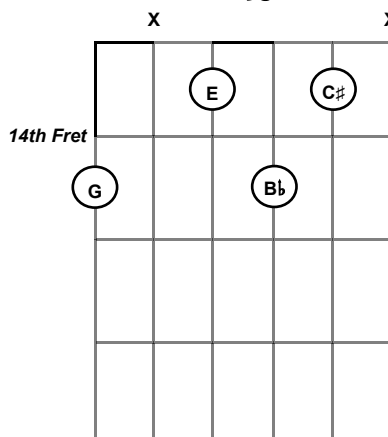
Can be played on either the 10th or 22nd fret.
