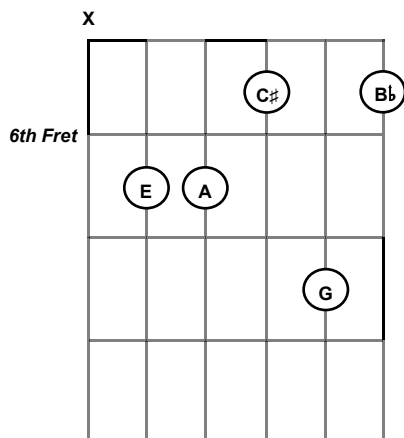


The $G7\flat 9$ chord can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret. It is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X". When we slide the $G7\flat 9$ up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

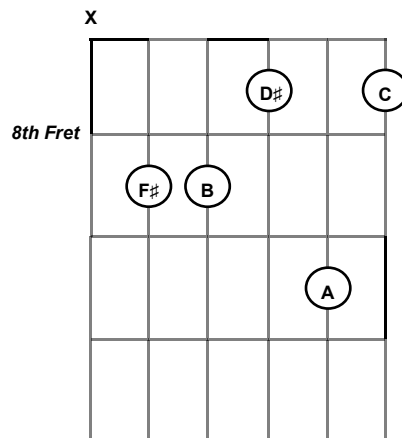

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.



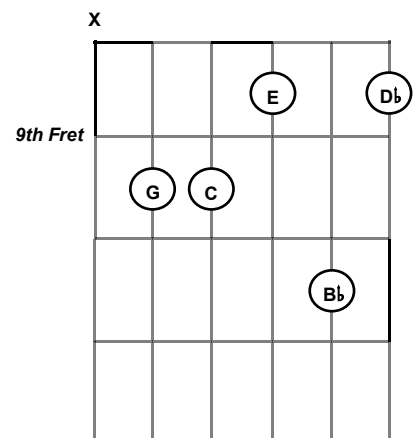
$B7\flat 9$

Can be played on either the 8th or 20th fret.

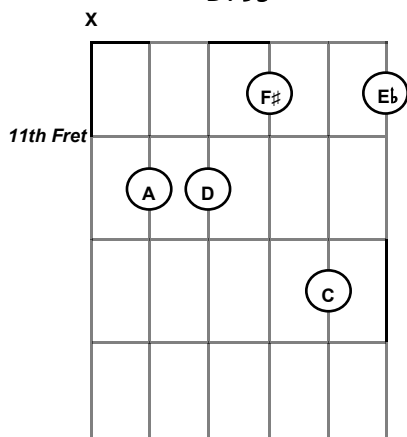


$C7\flat 9$

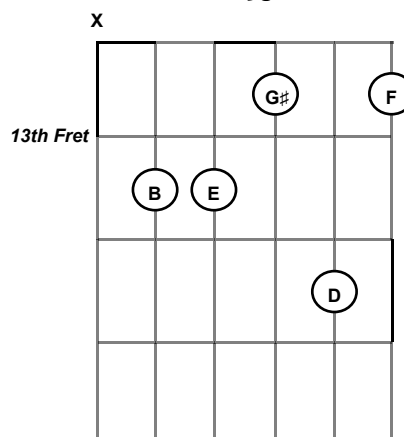
Can be played on either the 9th or 21st fret.
