

The G7 \sharp 5 chord is played without the 1st string. This is represented by "X." When we play the G7 \sharp 5 on the 12th fret, we play it without the 1st and 2nd strings, using the same configuration as the chords below. When we slide the G7 \sharp 5 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.




