



The G7 $\sharp$ 5 chord can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret. It is played without the 5th and 6th strings. This is represented by "X." When we slide the G7 $\sharp$ 5 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

A7♯5
Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



B7#5

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.



C7#5

Can be played on either the 8th or 20th fret.
