



MEDIC 94 INCIDENTS HISTORICAL (CY21 numbers are extrapolated from YTD data)



Statistically, this is counted as one incident. Monthly/ annual responses are determined by adding # of incidents plus number of dual paramedic responses.


INCIDENTS BY MUNICIPALITY-YTD 2021


Average Mobilization Time (Time call is received until responding): 1.4 minutes Average Response Time: (Time from responding to arrival on scene): 8.5 minutes


Engagement Time: (responding until patient contact) 11.5 minutes
