




# INCIDENTS HISTORICAL






#### **INCIDENTS BY MUNICIPALITY 2024**


#### **INCIDENT OUTCOME-2024**



#### **RECEIVING HOSPITALS-2024**




#### **RECEIVING HOSPITAL TRENDS- 2020-2024**
