




## INCIDENTS HISTORICAL






# **INCIDENTS BY MUNICIPALITY 2023**




# **INCIDENTS BY DAY OF THE WEEK-2023**




# **INCIDENTS BY HOUR OF THE DAY-2023**




## **INCIDENTS BY DISPATCH TYPE/ NATURE- 2023**




## **INCIDENT OUTCOME-2023**

# **RECEIVING HOSPITAL TRENDS- 2020-2023**




#### **OPERATIONAL TIMES- 2023**

Average Mobilization Time (Time call is received until responding): **1.5 minutes**Average Response Time: (Time from responding to arrival on scene): **8.5 minutes** 

Engagement Time: (responding until patient contact) 11.2 minutes

Average Scene Time: (Time from arrival on scene until depart scene): **16.1 minutes**Average Total Call Time: (Average from dispatch to available-all calls): **70 minutes** 

Average Call Time when patient transported: 111.5 minutes



## **CORPORATE NEWS**

- ➤ ChristianaCare West Grove Campus- No news about timetable or capabilities. We continue to assume that the emergency room will be open sometime in 2023.
- New Facility- The Penn Township Board of Supervisors approved the bid for the new Penn Township Emergency Services Building which will include the new home for MEDIC 94. The \$1.9 million project is partially funded by and \$850,000 grant form Chester County ARPA funds. Construction is expected to start in March with completion expected in the Fall of 2024.
