CFCM Study Group

Do you wish to increase your contracting knowledge, enhance your professional image, and set yourself apart in the industry? If your answer is “yes,” pursuing an NCMA certification may be the perfect next step, and the Jacksonville Chapter is here to support and assist!

NCMA certifications are the gold standard of professional excellence in contract management. The following are offered for those with the requisite experience, training and knowledge:

- Certified Commercial Contract Manager (CCCM)[™]
- Certified Federal Contract Manager (CFCM)[™]
- Certified Professional Contract Manager (CPCM)[™]

In particular, the Chapter has a strong track record of preparing chapter members and others for the prestigious CFCM certification. The 2019-2020 CFCM study group will run mid-January through June 2019. We provide study materials to qualified chapter members, and certified facilitators will lead biweekly study group sessions. Completing the study group earns 40 Continuous Learning Points (CLP's) and 40 hours of Continuing Professional Education (CPE).
