The Sharjah Environment and Protected Areas Authority (EPAA) has reviewed the Environmental Impact Assessment (ESIA) (395137 | 010 | C) for development of the Hamriyah Independent Power Project, provided by Mott MacDonald on behalf of GE Energy Financial Services/Sumitomo Corporation. The EPAA is satisfied appropriate consideration has been given to the potential environmental impacts and that mitigation measures presented are within reason. The EPAA hereby issues a No Objection Certificate with the following conditions:

- All relevant development and operational documentation comprising the Environmental Management Framework (EMF) must be submitted to the EPAA upon their completion, prior to the start of construction.
- The EMF must include a clear method statement for set-point ecological health monitoring of potentially impacted marine environments, annually for five years. The first survey must be carried out prior to the first water discharge. Results of ecological monitoring must be provided annually to the EPAA in writing.
- All mitigation measures stipulated by the ESIA to offset environmental harm must be integrated into the final design and construction of the power generation facility.
- In respect to identified localized contamination of the proposed onshore site, the EPAA must be notified in writing of any intent to dewater for the construction of the onshore facility, and must be provided with a clear contractor method statement prior to permission being granted for dewatering.
- During the construction phase of the project the EPAA must be provided with summary independent environmental audit reports every three months.
