DAY 1 – MONDAY, MARCH 6, 2023–VICTORIA TO HARRISON HOT SPRINGS
Depart Vancouver Island by ferry today. Upon arrival on the mainland a scenic drive brings us to Harrison Hot Springs Resort where, within the privacy of your hotel, you have access to the world renowned natural hot springs. After settling in, join your fellow travelers and Tour Director for dinner. **Today's dinner is included**

DAY 2 – TUESDAY, MARCH 7, 2023–HARRISON HOT SPRINGS
After breakfast, we will embark on a two-hour cruise in a covered, comfortable and heated boat down the serene Harrison River to the mighty Fraser River. Your guide will explain the history of the area as you witness historic First Nation burial sites and petroglyphs. Keep an eye out for a variety of birds and other wildlife. This afternoon we take a drive along the Fraser River to Yale. Yale played an important role in BC History during the gold rush days. Tour the Yale historic site which preserves local historic treasures and celebrates BC's gold rush history. Returning to the resort this afternoon take time to enjoy a warm soak in the natural, mineral-fed pools and hot tubs or take a lovely nature stroll through the surrounding rainforest. **Today's breakfast is included**

DAY 3 – WEDNESDAY, MARCH 8, 2023–HARRISON HOT SPRINGS
Today we explore the Harrison/Agassiz area including a visit to a local farm that produces handmade artisan cheeses. After sampling and looking in on the cheese -making process we change gears with a visit to the Sasquatch Museum. Next, we step back in time at the Agassiz Harrison Museum housed in the former wooden railroad station, the museum chronicles a fascinating local history . This evening we dine at a popular local restaurant. **Today's breakfast and dinner are included**

DAY 4 – THURSDAY, MARCH 9, 2023 –HARRISON HOT SPRINGS TO VICTORIA
We bid farewell to Harrison this morning and catch an afternoon ferry back to Victoria with memories evocative of the Harrison you now know. **Today's breakfast is included**
