Directions: Any individual, except a member of the award selection committee, may nominate or support *only one* nominee for this award in any given year.

Purpose: The award recognizes a person who, during a period of residence in the Southwest Region of the ACS, has made meritorious contributions to the advancement of chemistry, chemical engineering, chemical education, either pure or applied, to the profession in general.

Submittal process: A complete nomination packet consists of pages 2-3 of this form (completed), the nominator recommendation (limited to 750 words) and at least one support letter. Up to two support letters will be accepted.

The nomination package should be assembled as follows:

Page 1 – Completed Nominee and Nominator information page (see below)

Page 2 – Completed Support Letters page (see below)

Page 2 should be followed by: (1) Nominator Recommendation, (2) Nominee curriculum vitae or biographical sketch, (3) any support letters the nominator wishes to submit directly with the package.
