RESERVATION & ENTRY PROCEDURE

MAKE A RESERVATION: Please email rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com to make your stall reservations, request RV spaces, and order feed/bedding. All entries must have a reservation in order to enter the show. We respectfully ask that trainers make stall reservations on behalf of their whole barn to reduce any potential confusion. CANCELLATION DEADLINE: Entries/stalls not canceled by the deadline of 10/10/2025 will be responsible for paying a \$75 scratch fee per horse/stall. LATE ENTRIES: Any entries submitted after the deadline of 10/10/2025 will be responsible for paying a \$50 late fee. SUBMIT YOUR ENTRIES: Entries must be submitted by 10/10/2025 to be considered on time. Entries can be submitted online on ringradar.com or by emailing them directly to rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com

We accept check or credit card (3.5% processing fee) as forms of payment.

REGULAR CLASS ADD/SCRATCH POLICY:

ALL CHANGES (INCLUDING BOTH ADDS AND SCRATCHES) MADE BY 5PM THE DAY PRIOR TO THE CLASS WIILL NOT INCUR ANY FEES. ANY SAME DAY ADDS OR SCRATCHES WIILL BE CHARGED A \$5/CLASS FEE. CLASSES MUST BE SCRATCHED IN THE OFFICE, PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A REFUND (LESS THE \$5 SAME DAY FEE). IF YOU SCRATCH THEM AFTER THE START OF THE CLASS OR FAIL TO SCRATCH THEM IN THE OFFICE, YOU WILL BE CHARGED THE FULL ENTRY FEE. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIIGHT TO LIMIT SAME DAY ADDS IF THE SCHEDULE BECOMES TOO FULL. Show Rules & Policies

Payment: All payments should be paid by credit card, cash, or check made payable to Murieta Equestrian Center. Credit card payments incur a 3.5% processing fee. There will be a \$50 charge for all checks returned by the bank, or 10% of the check amount-whichever is greater. Once a check has been returned, a credit card will be required as payment for all future transactions. No numbers will be issued without an open check or credit card on file in the office.

Late Fee: Any entries received after the Closing Date (10/10/25) will be charged a \$50 Late Fee.

Show Scratches: Entries and stalls may be scratched and/or dropped up until the closing date of 10/10/25 without penalty. After 10/10/25, a \$75 per stall and/or scratched entry will be assessed for any cancellations.

Substitutions: If an entry is substituted (swapped) for a different entry after the closing date, the new horse can pay a substitution fee of \$75. No fees will be assessed for the cancelled entry.

Stalls: Permanent Premium Stalls and tack rooms will be available for \$350.00, 10' x 12' and 10' x 10' with top and bottom doors and dirt flooring. Hauling in is allowed at \$75.00 per horse per day. No bedding included. Water buckets and hoses must be provided by the exhibitor. NO straw or synthetic/paper materials permitted- only wood shavings. It is strictly forbidden to remove stall doors. Exhibitors will be billed for any damage to property. IF ANYTHING IS LEFT BEHIND IN THE BARNS, YOU WILL BE BILLED A MINIMUM OF \$500. IF SYRINGES ARE LEFT **CONTAINERS** ANYWHERE OTHER THAN THE BILLED \$500 PER PROVIDED, YOU WILL BE SYRINGE. THIS POLICY WILL BE **STRICTLY** ENFORCED.

Arenas: All show and warm-up arenas consist of sand/fiber footing. Jumper Rings 130' X 250', 130' X 220', Hunter Rings 100' X 230', 120'X 230'

Dogs: All dogs must be leashed and the leash must be in control of a responsible human handler.

Those in non-compliance may be fined an additional \$25 which will be added to the owner's bill, fine is at management's discretion.

Feed & Bedding: Feed and bedding can be ordered via email: rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com. All grain orders must be placed by Friday morning.



Attire: If competing in any judged class, riders must wear a hunt coat or a shirt with a collar, breeches and tall boots or jodhpurs. Any class offering prize money requires that the participant dress in formal attire (hunt coat & breeches in a traditional color). Cell Phones: Active use of cell phones and all cellular transmission devices is not permitted in any competition or warm-up arena.

Championships: Division Championships will be awarded in divisions where at least 3 of the classes in the division take place with 3 or more participants. In Hunter divisions, one of these classes must be the under saddle class. Points will be awarded as per current USEF rules.

Prize Money: In classes offering prize money, no prize money will be awarded if less than 3 entries compete. Payout: 30%–22%–15%–10%–7%–6%–5%–5% **Judging Criteria:** To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated.

Handy Hunter: For indicated hunter sections and divisions one class will feature a handy course. This course will be the second over fences class in each indicated section.

Emergency Medical Care: The closest emergency room is located at Mercy Hospital of Folsom, 15 miles from the Equestrian Center. 1650 Creekside Drive, Folsom, CA 95630

Level 1 Trauma Center: The closest Level 1 Trauma Center is located at UC Davis Medical Center, 24 miles from the Equestrian Center. 2315 Stockton Blvd., Sacramento, CA 95817

Horse Healthcare Requirements: Per GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Competitors may be asked to provide proof of vaccination upon check-in or prior to entering the property. All horses on the facility must have their temperature monitored twice daily for the 72 hours (3 days) prior to their arrival and throughout the duration of the show. Any horse exhibiting a temperature over 101.5 must be reported to management immediately.



Show Rules & Policies

Equine Surgery Center: The closest Equine Surgery Center is UC Davis Large Animal Hospital, 41 miles from the Equestrian Center. 1 Garrod Drive, Davis, CA 95616

Lunging: Lunging is only permitted in the warm-up arenas prior to the start of the show.

Helmets: Anyone riding a horse on Murieta Equestrian Center property must wear securely fastened protective headgear, which meets ASTM/SEI standards and carries the SEI tag. Any rider violating this rule at any time will immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show, the officials, contractors, and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his/her/their horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise.

Every Class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries, and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.

Non-Competing Horses: All horses on the grounds, regardless of whether competing or not competing must be declared to the show office. Non-Competing horses will pay a flat fee of \$200 plus a stall fee. If management discovers horses on the grounds that have not been declared to the show office, there will be a \$100 penalty charged in addition to the noncompeting fee of \$200.

Class Size: Classes with less than 3 may be combined or canceled. If entries warrant; large classes will be split.



Non-Comp/Hors Concours Round: Hors Concours rounds may be permitted, but only at management's discretion. If permitted, the cost is equal to that of the class that is intended. Once a horse competes an hors concours round, it may not compete in that subsequent classes for the remainder of the day.

Office Fee: Every horse entered in the competition will pay a \$125 Office fee. This fee covers access to all show arenas the day before the show begins for schooling purposes, medical personnel and emergency response, and entry software.

Ties: In the event of a tie, both will be awarded the placing tied for, unless otherwise stated.

RV Spaces: RV spaces must be reserved directly with RCEE by emailing rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com. The cost for RV spaces is \$300. This covers arrival on Monday and departure on Sunday. There is no nightly rate. Rigs arriving or departing outside of that timeframe will be assessed a \$25/night fee.

Haul Ins: All haul ins will be assessed a \$75 per show day fee, as well as the \$125 office fee.

Open Balances: Competitors who do not come into the office to close out at the end of the show forfeit the right to adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file. Competitors that fail to submit a valid form of payment for the full amount of their show bill by 5 p.m. on Sunday of the show week, will be charged a \$50 office fee.

Back Numbers: Anytime a horse is outside of its stall, it must be accompanied by its back number.

Prize Money: The total amount of rated and unrated prize money being offered in Hunter Classes at this show is: \$13,500.00 The total amount of rated and unrated prize money being offered in Jumper Classes at this show is: \$11,050.00

SafeSport: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. RULES & REGULATIONS



Membership Requirements Outreach Membership is free. All Outreach class participants must join as a USHJA Outreach member to be eligible for awards. Horses are not required to be registered with USHJA or be microchipped to compete in Outreach classes. USEF Membership/USHJA membership is not required in order compete in Outreach classes.

Points will accrue through sixth place for any class that has six or more entries. At least three entries must complete the course or class for points to count

- In classes with six or more entries, full points will accrue as follows: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2
- 5 entries: 6-4-2-1-1/24 entries: 4-2-1-1/2
- 3 entries: 2-1-1/2
- A rider's home zone will be determined by their place of residence during the current competition year. If a rider changes zones, because of school, work, or otherwise, he/she must request permission change his/her home zone to the USHJA in writing in order for his/her points to follow. Points will follow the USHJA competition year, December 1 to November 30.
- USHJA will provide certificates of merit in three categories in each USHJA Outreach section or class.
 - o 1. Bronze Level: riders must earn at least 30 points during the competition year
 - o 2. Silver Level: riders must earn at least 50 points during the competition year
 - o 3. Gold Level: riders must earn at least 75 points during the competition year
 - 4. Certificates will be awarded by zone, and if a zone banquet is held the zone committee is strongly encouraged to present USHJA Outreach certificates during the banquet. Otherwise certificates will be mailed. When a rider achieves Bronze the USHJA will mail the certificate at that time. Presentations of Silver and Gold certificates will be awarded at the end of the year.

Hunters All courses will have at least seven jumps and no combinations are allowed. For each section, only the first three numbered over fences classes, regardless of how many classes are held, and one under saddle class in each hunter section will count for USHJA Outreach points.

Jumpers All courses will have at least seven jumps and no combinations are allowed. Classes 0.70m and below will not have oxers. Tables are indicated on the class schedule.

Equitation All courses will have at least seven jumps and no combinations are allowed. For each section, only the first three numbered over fences classes, regardless of how many classes are held, and one flat class in each equitation section will count for USHJA Outreach points. Riders must be juniors or amateurs. Points

2'0" Child/Adult Hunter Derby This class will be one round, consisting of no less than 8 fences. No oxers. The course will consist of hunter classic and hunter handy-style lines, turns and jumps. The judge will give one score. No options will be given. See class list for additional classes required to compete in this class.

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7)assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

SCHOOLING POLICIES

Morning hacking is permitted up to 1 hour prior to the start of the arena. No Jumping is allowed in any of the arenas during morning hacking.


Afternoon schooling is permitted with management permission, only after the course has been set for the following day.
