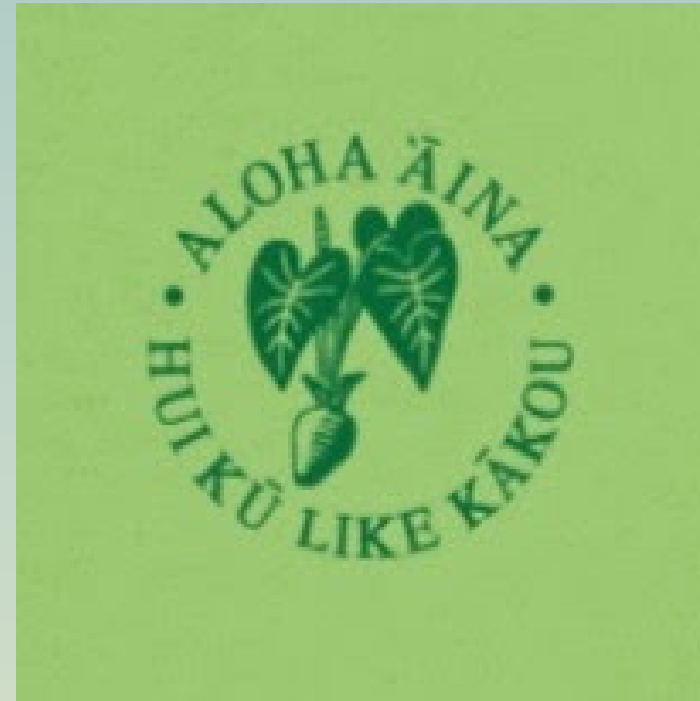


HUI KŪ LIKE KĀKOU

Hui Kū Like Kākou (HKLK) is led by Kānaka 'Ōiwi and has participants from local community and kama'āina near and far.

Our 'ohana originates from many peoples, cultures, and faiths. All are welcome to learn and share together with HKLK.



The goals of Hui Kū Like Kākou are to:

- Reclaim Kānaka 'Ōiwi identity,
- Provide kūpuna (elders) with healthy, traditional, local foods, and
- Resist oppressive systems through nourishing the hearts and minds of all visitors to the Wai'anae Moku of O'ahu through the practice of aloha 'āina (loving the land).



Guiding with Aloha 'Āina

The Goddess Kaiona watches over the Wai'anae Valley, helping those who are lost find their way. Those who find themselves with HKLK, also find peace and joy through loving the land.



Lo'i Day: Sustainable Sundays

Through the sharing of cultural teachings, knowledge holders educate community members, locals, and visitors about the worldview, traditions, and values of Kānaka 'Ōiwi. HKLK plants and tends kalo in the lo'i, while harvesting laughter and deeper understanding of their place in the world.



Resist Oppression: Kū'ē, every day!

Most recently, several HKLK plan to attend an event in Aotearoa (New Zealand) in October 2026: Dismantling the Doctrine of Discovery summit. This international gathering convenes advocates to collaborate and strategize on rejecting the fictions of the Doctrine, dismantling the domination it has caused, and restoring Indigenous justice around the world.

What is the Doctrine of Discovery?

A series of 15th -century decrees from the Vatican which asserted that Christian European nations had the right to claim and seize lands inhabited by non-Christians and assert dominance over Indigenous Peoples - the justification for colonization around the world which perpetuates to this day.

WE ARE EXPLORING WAYS TO DISMANTLE THE DOCTRINE

Approximately 22 members of Hui Kū Like Kākou (HKLK) plan to make the voyage to Aotearoa, responding to the call of Indigenous Peoples across the Pacific. HKLK will be presenting on the following topics at the summit:

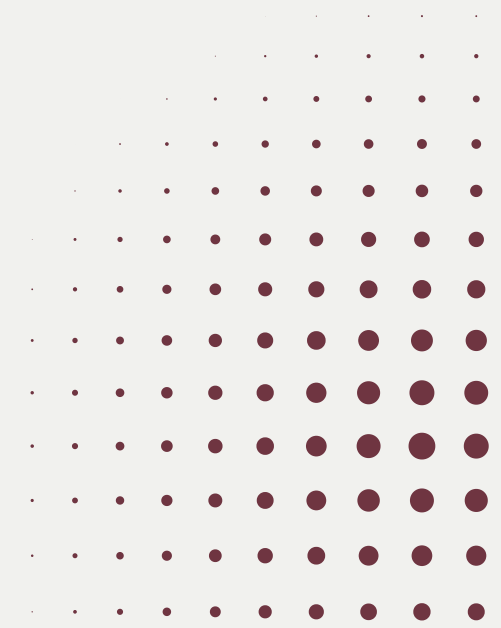
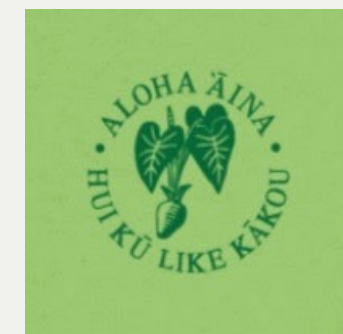

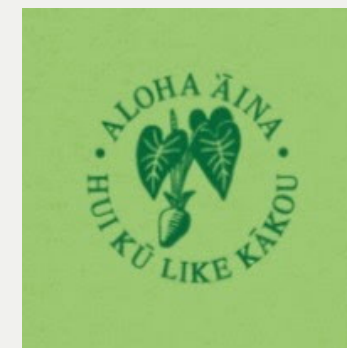
