Ada County USBC Senior 9 Pin No Tap Tournament Rules

1. Bowling Center: Bowling will be conducted at Meridian Bowling Lanes, 324 S. Meridian Rd., Meridian, ID
2. Eligibility: This tournament is open to all Seniors age 50 and over who are members of the Ada County USBC and members in good standing holding a current 2025-2026 membership card at the time of the tournament. If a bowler wishes to bowl and is not a member of the Ada County USBC, the bowler must purchase a local card, in the amount of \$7.00, and fill out the proper membership at that time. USBC Membership cards will be shown to a tournament official upon check-in.
3. No entry money will be refunded if it is discovered that an individual has failed to comply with all USBC eligibility requirements.
4. The highest league certified average of 21 or more games in the 2024-2025 season must be used. If the entrant does not have a 21-game average, but does have 21 games by the closing date, the Tournament Director has the option to use that average. Entrants average must come from a standard 10 pin league or they will be required to bowl scratch in the event. If none of those conditions apply, then the bowler must bowl scratch. Entrants shall bowl with the same hand used to establish the entering average.
5. Handicap for this event will be 90% of 220.
6. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the bowler's team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make corrections prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify the bowler's score, if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. If the submitted average is higher, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. See USBC Rule 319a.
7. No entrants will be able to practice on scheduled tournament lanes prior to bowling the tournament for any such reason.
8. Entrants must report to the tournament office at least 30 minutes prior to bowling and must show their USBC card.
9. Prize Fund will be returned 100% based on a minimum of 1 in 10 entry ratio.
10. Team Strength: Two bowlers – teams may consist of two men, two women, or one man and one woman. Bowlers may bowl as many times as desired, however, no individual may place more than one place in the prize fund with the same partner.
11. Any rules not covered herein will be in accordance with USBC.
