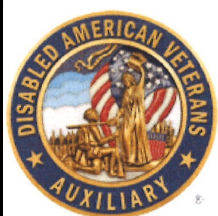

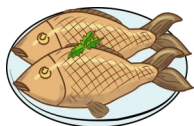

Gold Star Mother's and Family Day

American Gold Star Mothers, Inc. is an organization of mothers whose sons/daughters served and died while serving their nation in times of war or conflict. American Gold Star Mothers, Inc. was incorporated in 1929 by obtaining a federal charter from the US Congress. The group began with 25 mothers living in the Washington DC area and soon expanded to include affiliated groups throughout the nation.

On June 23, 1936, a joint congressional resolution designated the last Sunday in September as Gold Star Mother's Day and is proclaimed annually by each president. President Obama amended the day, in 2011 to "Gold Star Mother's and Family's Day".

Army Captain Robert L. Queissner, whose two sons were serving on the front-line during World War I, created what is now called the Service Flag. The Service Flag was created for families to display in their front window. Each blue star denotes a child serving in the military during times of war or hostilities. When a service member dies, families stitched a gold star over the blue star.

Each year on Gold Star Mother's and Family Day the United States President calls on all Americans to display the nation's flag and hold appropriate meetings to publicly express their love, sorrow, and reverence towards Gold Star Mothers and their families. Service organizations provide opportunities for the family through ceremonies, luncheons, and teas. Some take place at military memorial sights and veteran cemeteries.

On another note, I am stepping down from this position due to health reasons. I still plan on attending meetings and lending support as I can. Thank you for allowing me to serve as your Post Chaplain.
