- **The trial is being run as a flexible format trial and the club reserves the right to change the Premium stated Running order of stakes and/or judges if conditions warrant.**
- **Entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in available daylight hours if this occurs prior to closing.**
- **Single course with Quail released on course except for the puppy stake.**
- **A blank cartridge will not be fired in Open Puppy.**
- **AKC approved tracking collars permitted in all stakes but not provided.** The locator for any collar used will be controlled by the field trial marshal and will be activated only after the dog has been eliminated from competition.
- **Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes.**
- **Cell phones cannot be used on the course.**

Turn right on CR 3325 and immediately turn left to continue CR 3322 Loop until you see the "Dead End" sign and red cone. CR 3325 curves to the right, with a sharp 90 degree turn; go past the silo and cattle pens. The road will curve to the left and there will be a P3 Porter Ranch double gate on the right which is the entrance for the campgrounds and club house.

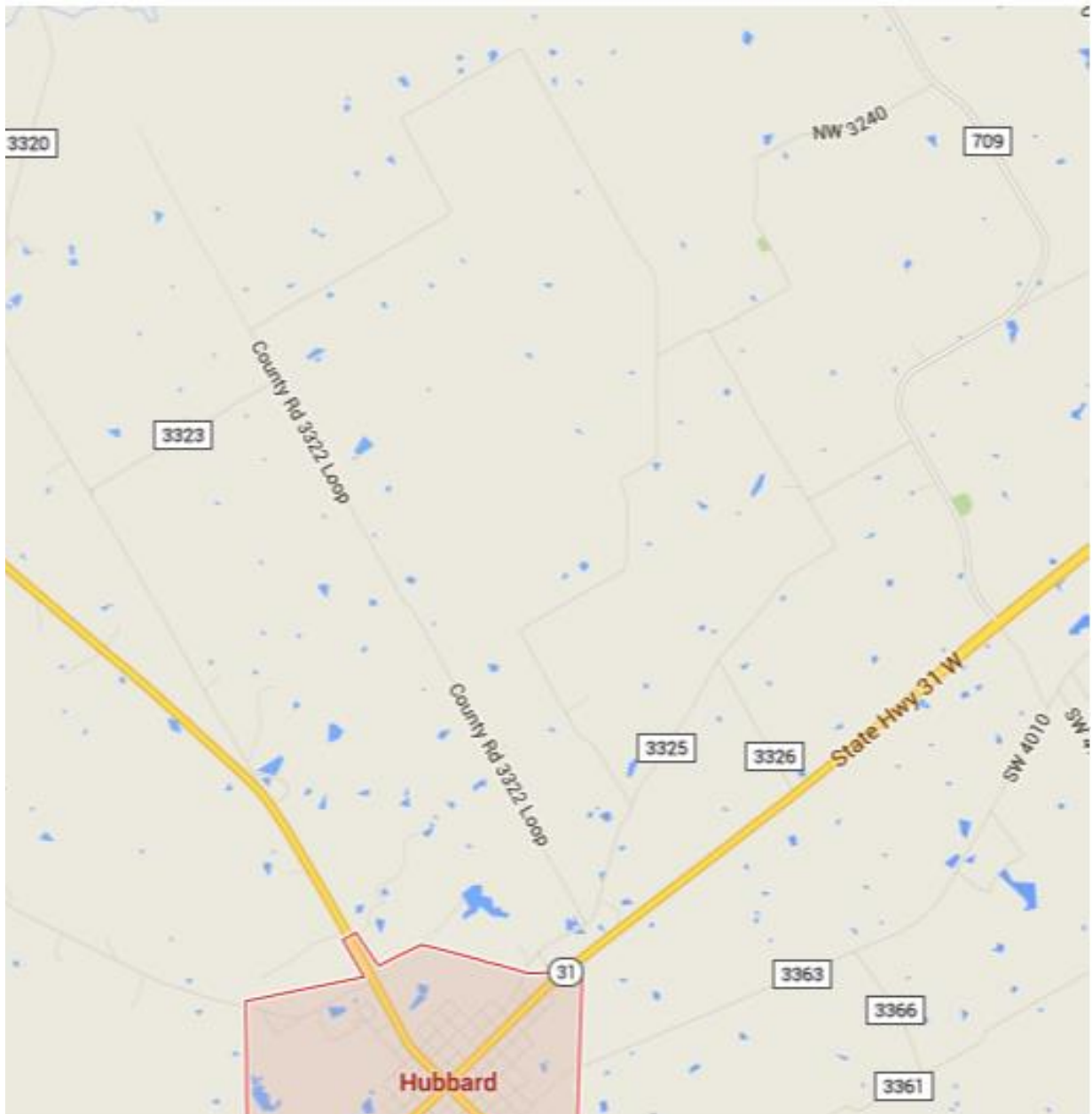
