

We are so excited that your child is joining us for our 13th Annual Summer Theater Day Camp. In this letter, you will find all the information to prepare your child and yourself for a great camp experience.

Here is all the info you need:

Dates and Times

Camp is every weekday Monday, June 19 - Friday, June 30 from 9:00am-4:00pm. Please drop off and pick up your child on time. Please do not drop your child earlier than 10 minutes, or pick them up later than 10 minutes.

Performance Times

The performances of *The Wizard of Oz* will be Friday, June 28 at 3:00pm and 7:00pm. Both performances will be held in the Joy Center at the church and are free. Each family will receive two reserved seats in one of the front 5 rows. All other seating is first come, first seated.

Lunch/Food

Please send your child with a lunch every day. Please do not pack anything that needs to be refrigerated or heated, as campers will not have access to a kitchen. We will provide a morning and afternoon snack, as well as water throughout the day. There is a water refill station so feel free to send your child with a water bottle.

Sign In/Sign Out

You will need to sign your child in and out of camp every day in the lobby of the Joy Center. If someone other than those listed on your child's registration form will be picking them up, we will need to have prior notice from you in writing.

Supplies to Bring to Camp Every Day

Your child we will receive their show script on the first day of camp. Please make sure they bring it every day to camp along with their lunch. Your child will also need to bring a beach towel, marked with their name, each Monday. The towel will remain at camp for the week and will be brought home the first Friday and the second Thursday.

Clothing

Please make sure your child wears appropriate clothing to camp. Remember they will be out in the sun throughout the day as well as moving around in rehearsals and should dress accordingly. Sunscreen should be applied in the morning. Your child will receive a camp shirt the first day. While they are not required to wear it everyday, we highly encourage wearing it as often as possible.

We will also have theme dress days throughout camp. There will be crazy sock day, Hawaiian dress day, Disney day, and crazy hair day. Again these are optional, but it's fun to participate!

Close-toed shoes are always required (even on water days). <u>No sandals or flip-flops</u>. If your child is dropped off in improper shoes, you will be asked to return with correct shoes.

Wizard of Oz Auditions and CD

You will receive a second email from Dropbox.com that contains all the music for *The Wizard of Oz.* Please have your child listen to it over the next few weeks and familiarize themselves with the music.

Auditions for the show will be the first day of camp after lunch. We will go over audition material in the morning, but again, the more familiar they are with the music, the better chance they will have at receiving a role. They may select 30 seconds to 1 minute of any song they like to sing at the auditions.

Costumes and Makeup for Show

We will provide the costumes for the show as well as any special makeup. You are responsible to provide undergarments that your child feels comfortable changing in and shoes. More details on these personal items will be sent once the show is cast.

Activities

Every day your child will participate in outside group games, inside activities, and craft time with children in his or her own age group. They must take their craft home every day so please be sure to pick it up on the table when you sign them out.

Water Days

The first Friday and second Thursday of camp will be water days. Your child should wear normal camp clothing (please no bathing suits). Water games will be the last activity of the day. You may want to plan accordingly if your child goes somewhere after camp.

Enrichments

We are once again offering the campers the opportunity to take two enrichment classes, which occur on Tuesday and Wednesday of each week.

Please fill out the attached google form to select any enrichment class that looks interesting. We will do our best to make sure every camper gets at least one of their choices.

If we do not receive your child's choices by June 14, they will be assigned to an open enrichment class.
