Wednesday UNite Fellowship meal February 1st. Please join us!


Our youth group will eat with us and meals will be delivered to our shut-ins by our God's Love... It's Cooking team.

Worship: Standing in Awe

"I was there when He set the heavens in place, when He marked out the horizon on the face of the deep, when He established the clouds above and fixed securely the foundations of the deep. When He gave the sea its boundary so the waters would not overstep His command, and when He marked out the foundations of the earth. Then I was the craftsman at His side." Proverbs Ch. 8 is a hymn describing wisdom's role in creation, the "I" in the first and last verse could be translated "Wisdom" and/or possibly be referring to "Jesus".
