


Amen Corner!



Last week I had the good pleasure of attending the Regional Assembly of the Christian Church in Oklahoma. I got to attend a ministers training seminar which serves as continuing education. I had a new experience where we had worship around the dinner table on Friday night. On Saturday we had the joy of visiting with other church leaders to hear how to problem solve some issues in all of our congregations. Then we heard reports from the business session and installed our new Regional Minister, Michael Davison. It was a great weekend event and a great opportunity to meet up with our fellow disciples across the state.

This Sunday we retell the story of the man born blind found in John 9. It is an epic length of scripture to read, much like last Sunday's reading. The opening of our scripture reading seeks to lay blame on someone for why this blindness has occurred. "Who's sin caused this blindness? The man or his parents?" How often do we look for blame before we look for a cure? The story unfolds with this blind man receiving his sight, and the rest of the world, especially the Pharisees, try to digest how that miracle happens and who gets the glory for this spectacular chain of events. For the religious authorities, this story shows how Jesus disregards the law of remembering the Sabbath day and keeping it holy. There is a direct link between this healing, and how Jesus is crucified on a cross in John chapter 19. We are drawing nearer to Jesus' passion. Soon Jesus will enter Jerusalem with celebration. He will leave under the weight of a cross and the judgement of state leaders, and crucified for daring to give light and life to others.

I am glad to be with you in this faith journey. May God grace us in the days and weeks to come. Blessings, Rev. John Wheeler
