The Amen Corner

The Stewardship Campaign is upon us. These last few weeks I have been reading "Not Your Parents' Offering Plate" which teaches about stimulating church finances to grow. I have been praying how this might make a difference in our congregation. I realize that some of the ideas are a bit radical, like inviting members to offer a testimony of why they give to the church every Sunday of the year. Fifty-two times a year, hearing why someone gives to the church might be difficult. According to the author the top three reasons people give to church and non-profits are: 1. belief in the mission, 2. regard for the leadership, and 3. fiscal responsibility.

Sometimes churches have a hard time communicating the good they do because there is a scriptural precedent that the right hand not know what the left hand is doing (Matthew 6:3). I have heard on occasion people ask me to talk more about what is happening at church. Because unless you are in the middle of it, you might miss all the ways the ministries branch out from the roots and vine. You will read in a letter from me that accompanies the pledge form about some of the successes at the church.

I think one of our strengths is the hospitality we provide to others. We have opened our church to Girl Scout troop 478. We have shared space with the Scout Troop (they are girls) 9434 for years. We have hosted the daycare in our building for 59 years, since August 1, 1966! There are other groups, alumni clubs, bridge clubs, fellowships that have visited us. And we cannot whisper the word "hospitality" without remembering all the work our Bereavement Teams perform in making meals for families who've suffered the passing of a loved one.

As this month progresses, I hope to share more stories about the good things experienced at First Christian Church.
