I am a disciple of Christ. I'm also a Disciple of Christ and I'm not being redundant. I am persuaded Jesus of Nazareth is the Christ, the son of the living God, and I try to follow him insofar as I see the way and can muster up the will. This isn't stellar discipleship, so I count heavy of grace. I sleep well. I'm also an intentional member of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and whatever our skeletons may be, it's my spiritual home of origin. Some religious communities have credal statements that define who is, and who isn't, on board. Many subscribe to doctrines worked out when the world was flat. We don't. We have slogans such as "No creed but Christ".

Mostly what we have is an ethos, an attitude that typifies what matters to us. Our ethos is strong on the responsibility of the believer to think about what he/she believes and be true to it. Equally important is a determined willingness to let our sister/brother make their own choices as God leads them. Our ethos is one that actively resists being told what to think, what to believe and how to behave. If that means someone seems unscriptural in their thoughts and actions, I'm confident we have a God bigger and broader than we can conceive. We have a way to salvation that isn't a minefield. No one is saved because they're successfully, diligently scriptural, but because God is just that good.

The Disciple ethos works at being inclusive and welcoming to all. About the only thing a person can do to become unwelcome is make someone else feel unwelcome. This is the church I joined long ago. I hope it's the church you joined too.


VIRTUAL REGIONAL ASSEMBLY
