## The Amen Corner

Like many of you I like to read highway signs when I am traveling. They usually tell me much about 'where' I am & to 'what' might be ahead. This is information I can either submit to my brain or delete! What a wonderful way to live in this tiring world. We have abundant choices!

Some of the signs in our lives as Christians should probably be read TWICE! For instance on Highway 81 that paves its way through our community, there are several signs that read "WE ARE HIRING." Let's put that sign to work....by asking ourselves, 'where is my work, why is that my work and when do I begin?"

If you will, open your Bible to your favorite passage or to a passage with which you may have questions. I will wait.

One of my favorites (to question) is 1 Corinthians 3:9 which reminds me we are God's workers. This passage is referring to divisions in the church at Corinth. It tells us to beware of any work God which enables us to evade concentration on Him. As an engineer of creation, God has a plan. He tells us our great aim is to pour out a whole-hearted devotion to Him in His creation. The manual labor is a side-line of being God's coworker.

When you have time, read or reread the passage you have chosen and discuss it with God. Ask Him, 'where is my work in this passage, why and, when?' I am confident you will find His answer to be as mine.

Now, let's think about the 'highway sign' our Search Committee faces. It reads: WE ARE HIRING!

Then let's ask ourselves, 'where, why, and when' may I be a part of that work? The answer? Love God with ALL your heart. He has our soul in His hands.
