The Amen Corner

Preaching has always been an exciting adventure for me. Something like swinging from a trapeze without a net. Suffice it to say, I sleep better on Sunday night than Saturday. The past few weeks have been a special adventure as I've dealt with Matthew 5:1-12, the Beatitudes. For those who don't know, these are a list of blessings to those who dedicate themselves to living in God's world on God's terms. FYI, to be "Blessed" essentially means to have life be the best it can be. In Jesus' scheme of things, the best of life isn't related to money, power, brains, youth and good looks. (Don't you hate that?) Instead, he offers great joy for the oddest things. Just two examples:

Jesus said, "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." To the 21st Century American, "poor in spirit" is an unfortunate phrase. It led me to discover a new word, "Anhedonia". It refers to someone unable to experience pleasure. How do you like that? I've known Christians who seemed to think being a true believer meant an absence of pleasure. Their idea of "poor in spirit" is a lot like poor old Eevore, Christopher Robin's chronically gloomy donkey. That's not it. "Poor in spirit" refers to that in a person who knows she can't earn salvation, the guy who accepts absolute dependence on the mercy of God. Embrace these as the reality and we allow God to be God and discover the goodness of God. This is when life has a chance of becoming abundant indeed!

Jesus said, "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth." Did anything ever sound more counterintuitive? More stupid? "Meek" in our culture reeks of Casper Milquetoast, the guy who speaks softly and gets hit over the head with a big stick. He's going to "inherit the earth?" Land on the top of the heap? I don't think so. I also don't think it's the Bible's fault we have an unfortunate translation with the word "Meek." The Greek word Matthew used is "Praus." It was an important word to Aristotle 4 centuries before Jesus. It has to do with striking the right balance. Ever known someone who was indifferent in the face of cruelty? Or another who flew off the handle over every insult, real and imaginary? Societies decline with the one and people go to jail for the other. Praus, or "Meekness" has to do with getting angry over the right stuff. This is the creative anger over kids not having coats and people being excluded from the ballot box, and the starting salary of Oklahoma school teachers being about \$5,000 below other Americans 20-25 years old. It gets worse as they get older. These are things meek people get angry about and when they do, they change their worlds.

Having fun with the Beatitudes. We finish up this Sunday. Hope you're interested.
