### The Amen Corner

Excuse me while I catch my breath; I just finished cardiac rehab, a form of penance Dr. Bill Stewart laid on me following my recent cardio vascular adventure. I show up 3 mornings a week and Iordan Keeler bosses me around for an hour, making me do things I would've been doing all along. In the process, good things are happening. Every once in a while, some other kind of health expert shows up to talk to us about how to get out of cardiac rehab and stay out. Today it was diet or die expert, Dear Iov Galloway. I listened intently. I've heard her before but I always catch something new that might help me live longer and healthier. (Onions and cabbage: you can eat all of them you want; they're freebies. Good to know though, I'd rather she said fried corn.) Of course, several weeks of this business will be to no avail if it ends with my required sessions. It has to continue and I think that's their scheme; you go through rehab straight to the Simmons Center and this sort of workout becomes a "lifestyle." I'm persuaded "Lifestyle" is another way of addressing habits.

Our lives are collections of habits, some good and some not so much. Years ago, I heard an anthropologist being interviewed when she broke out into a speech. Said she, "Nature wants you to make it to 30. Nature needs you to make it to 30. So, you can eat what you want, drink what you want, smoke what you want and do whatever you want because nature needs you to make it to 30. After 30, you're on your own.' Such sad wisdom. Ever notice how few people take up glue sniffing at 40? If you're willing to walk a mile for a Camel, there's a good chance you can't. If you can, you probably won't. I can. I won't. Much of my life's work has to do with our habits. I've noticed that prayer and reflection, regular participation in worship, studying scriptures and thinking about things of eternal import are habits people make. The more developed such habits, the greater the chance they also make a habit of being generous and tolerant, kind and merciful. It works the other way too, certainly.

Today finds all of us needing to pick up some good habits, dropping others. I hope being a part of this faith community helps.


