Louis VII was King of the Franks in the 12th Century, looking to make his kingdom greater than his dad, and trying to defend it from the French-speaking king of England. Louis was also a city-maker. Paris was a provincial city that smelled to high heaven and was governed by church bells that rang 8 times a day. Louis intended to make it a capital capitol and so, started up the University of Paris in 1150. In 1163, he started a big city cathedral called "Our Lady of Paris". It sounds swankier in French, "Notre Dame de Paris". It took about 150 years and since then it's seen a lot

In 1431, Joan of Arc's mother argued against her daughter being a heretic. The English burned her at the stake. In 1807, they made her a saint and put her statue in Notre Dame. During the French Revolution, the radicals took over and took over the cathedral. Anything too religious was carted off and the building was desecrated. When Napoleon was coronated, the building was a church again and he took the crown from the pope and placed it on his head his own self. Lots of history.

Here on the Monday of Holy Week, it caught fire, probably because of faulty modern elevator wire near the ancient oak spire. Despite original fears, it seems reparable. President Marcon claims to have it up and running in 5 years. That's a remarkably short time for such a resurrection but long by standards. Still, it's testament to rebirth, and not giving in to all that tells us to. I wish them well. While we're at it, other church houses have been burned recently and not because of accidents. I wish them well too. As Easter comes, let's all celebrate miracles.


