## The Amen Corner

It's Baccalaureate Time again and I'm reminded of the spiritual direction I once heard from a preacher I'll call Whole E. Joe. On a warm Sunday afternoon, I was in an un air-conditioned auditorium, wishing for an air-conditioned nap when he said what he said and it woke me up completely. It was a simple statement, and straightforward. To these soon-to-be graduates, he spoke of a reckless and dangerous world and advised them, "Be like me." Said I (out loud) was, "What? What did he just say?" I kept listening. Maybe he might say something that would make sense of that advice. He might say, "I have to struggle with new ideas and change and even temptation, but I stay in that struggle. Do that!" He might have confessed, "I make my share of mistakes, but I try to pick myself up and carry on. You can do that!" I'd find that inspirational. He could have sounded very preacher-like had he said, "Daily, I die to sin but daily, I am raised up by the grace of Christ. Believe in that possibility for yourself." Amen, Brother. All the above would have had lots of merit but his message was none of that. It was just as I was shocked to hear in near slumber. He pointed to himself as a paragon of virtue and Godly righteousness. He offered himself as an example for these teenagers to emulate. I could have told him, "Be like me and don't do that!"

That kind of thinking, and talking, never ends well for anyone. I find it better to play down people's expectations as to one's high moral character. It was in flaunting his loyalty to Christ, Peter was told he would deny his friend 3 times in one evening. Better to be like the man with the stricken son who cried to Jesus, "I believe; help my unbelief!" Or, the wonderful admission of Paul to the Romans, "For the good I would I do not and the evil I would not do; that I do." Yes, I could have told Bro. Joe such posturing wouldn't end well. For him it didn't. Eventually, he was discovered to be a real person after all and it was too much for all to bear, high up on that pedestal. He does other things now.

To our pending graduates: try to remember your life, and adventures, are gifts from a God who loves you when you get things right, and get them wrong. If you take a class in college that makes you question whether you believe in God, that's okay; God will keep believing in you. If you find yourself tempted to tell anyone you're virtuous, don't do that! You're not. None of us are. Don't be a chump.


