# CELEBRATING PENTECOST

# This Sunday, June 9



Pentecost denotes the ancient "Feast of Weeks" in which Israel celebrated the giving of the Law on Mt. Sinai 7 weeks and 1 day after the Festival of Unleavened Bread, the Passover. It's celebrated among the Jewish community as the harvest of festival Shavuot, a festival of reaping and day of first fruits. In the Christian tradition, Pentecost commemorates the gift of the Holy Spirit poured out on the followers of Christ fifty days after Christ's resurrection as they were all together in Jerusalem on the day of Pentecost.

In Acts 2 we read, "On the day of Pentecost there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind and it filled the entire house where they were sitting, and divided tongues, as if fire appeared to them and rested on each of them and they were filled with the Holy Spirit..." The Holy Spirit empowered the followers of Christ with many and varied gifts for the witness and building up of the church. On that day about 3,000 were added to their numbers. Pentecost represents the birthdate of the Holy & Apostolic Church.

This Sunday you're encouraged to wear red to celebrate this great gift which continues to bless us today.

# The Amen Corner

When Apollos came to Ephesus, he stayed with some Christians, Aquila and Priscila. It became evident this erudite, young preacher didn't know everything. It could have been a "Gotcha" moment. Instead, they took him aside to teach him the way more righteous.

Among my souvenirs is a group picture taken after my ordination. There are 11 of us but I'm the one in the middle front with the long hair, beard and rimless glasses. The only thing that dates us more is Jim Davis, an elder in a white, western, leisure suit. A few months later, he would lose a daughter, and his marriage. Bill Elder would lose a sweet young son in a trampoline accident. Last time I saw him was on TV, when he rode a tractor to Washington for a farmers strike. My favorite professor, Oliver Reed Whitley, spoke; he wore a robe that let us remember he went to Yale and we didn't. He was a Disciple historian of the 1st order. George Cherryhomes is in the back. He was among the last missionaries to escape China when Mao took over, and convinced freedom would return and the church would persevere; he was right. Another was a woman professor, unusual then, Jean Schmidt, a feminist with a sweet heart. The host, Donald Helseth, is by my side. Don was a real mentor to me; his sage advice included wearing white shirts and black shoes on Sunday in fear I'd show up as though fresh from a flower power conclave Haight-Ashbury. Later, he apologized but I told him he'd been right to worry. Then there was the regional minister, Walter Lantz, an altogether decent man. He gave a charge that repeatedly instructed me in various circumstances to, "Remember Jesus." Remarkable how hard that is to keep in mind.

Flatt and Scruggs weren't at my ordination but they come to mind. They sang a song that includes, "They left one by one/ As their work here was done/ Gone home/ Gone home." All but 3 in the picture have gone home. Still, I'm ever grateful for those saints, and the encouragement they gave me.

As Trevor Evans begins his service with us I know many of you will do such things as you can to build him up. If you do, he will remember you by name.
