Dear Care Team & GLIC Members,

First of all, thank you for always sending love to our homebound church members by providing them with a yummy meal, served with kind hearts! The Care Ministry would really appreciate your teams continue working together in the upcoming church year of 2020 to 2021.

We've made the decision to draw from a resource already offered to church members — our Wednesday evening meals in the fall and spring. Your team would still cover your same week but instead of preparing and delivering on Saturdays, you'll pick up food at 5(ish) and then deliver.

The scheduled team will decide how many meals are needed that week and will give the count to our Kitchen Hostess so she can prepare the additional meals for GLIC. We'll keep the process of who needs meals the same, with suggestions from Arnold, our elders and notifications from church members. You'll continue getting an email with a list of recipients; it will just come on Mondays, as that is deadline to sign up for meals.

Something else we've talked about is delivering another serving for our members to have later in the week — perhaps frozen cooked chicken breasts, meatloaf, or even a store-bought chicken pot pie. This is optional and strictly up to each individual team.


When Wednesday UNite is NOT in session, each of our teams will prepare meals just as they've done before but deliver on Wednesday evenings.

Our hope behind this change is to free up Saturdays for folks and ease up a little work for our team members, which might help us draw in a few more helpers. We're planning to start GLIC up again in September, but if you hear of any needs prior to that, please let me, Erica, or Arnold know.
