Miss Winn taught American History like it mattered; she taught dad before me. Mrs. Bouseman sort of taught me biology. The Beautiful Mrs. Settle almost taught me Canterbury Tales. Mrs. Wright taught me to sing, and was a dear mv sister was killed. Woodland taught me to stand up straight and speak to the back of the room. Is "Hero" too great a word? Maybe. Still, worthy of admiration and gratitude is on target. Before high school, Miss Bourne had taught me to read in 4<sup>th</sup> grade, but she also taught me not to dare any other fool kid to jump from a 2<sup>nd</sup> story window. In 6th grade, Mrs. Brewer used white mice to teach us to eat right. After Christmas, she had us write about what we got. One boy got a pillow. We all remarked on that being a stupid present and Mrs. Brewer made the case for it being great, doing what she could to save his dignity, and teaching us to just shut up sometimes. I wonder how many times she had to contend with issues of poverty, want, and loss of dignity. A lot I bet. In 5th grade, Mrs. Freeman had to deal with a boy who was in the class one week; his parents traveled with a carnival. All the above had to deal with the troubles and challenges of life, keep us in line and teach. It's the same now but harder. Imagine having action plans for shooters in our schools!
