#### Dear Friends,

Our staple diet (sadza) maize meal is there in the shops but with 95% of unemployment, very few can afford to buy any. I have not seen a situation as bad as this one in my life.

So what you have done for my Pastors, I cannot thank you more. You have made it possible for them to provide basic food requirements for their families.

# The Amen Corner


Despite sound evidence, the Authorized Version of the Bible was published in 1611 under authority of "the most dread Sovereign," King James I of Great Britain, with the intention of scripture untainted with "popish" prejudices, there exist today people convinced this King James Version is the only English translation to be used because it was the very one used by Jesus.

A community of faithful claim heaven can only hold 144,000. That community now numbers more than 8 million. There are some who feel a duty to a kingdom not of this world such they won't pledge allegiance to a flag, serve in the military, hold public office, or vote. The majority of Christians claim belief in a Triune God because they were taught to and never gave it much thought. A minority have a hard time with "one God in Three persons." In the Age Reformation, a man fled his home for fear of his life over this. He sought safe haven elsewhere. Elsewhere they burned him at the stake.

People came to America to escape that but here, they developed groups that believed God, cursed slavery and others believing it was God's idea. They would shun members and family over dancing, smoking, taking a drink, and voting "wrong." A group I knew, shunned a sister community because the latter had a kitchen.

These issues are gravely important in their quarters but silly to others. All have caused grief. What do you believe is important? I know what I do. I believe Jesus is the Christ and son of God. I believe all who accept Him are to follow Him as each is led. I believe that apart from the Good Confession, there should be no test of fellowship between disciples of Christ. I believe "no" means "no." I hope you believe much the same.


