A Glossary of Terms

Sacred: entitled to respect, deemed especially dear

Holy: held in religious veneration Secular: of the world, and not religion Defile: to make filthy, pollute

Profane: to treat what is sacred with irreverence, contempt, and disregard

People say, "Is nothing sacred anymore?" I understand the concern. As an example, times for worship on Sundays no longer have a monopoly on what one can do with a Sunday morning. Some of us are bothered we live in a secular world that won't bend to our claimed values. Frankly, I'm good with that. I don't want everyone to act like Christian values, just Christians. When we think of the Sacred we're apt to mean "Holy", so the word is packed with religious baggage. Well, I think holy things certainly are sacred but I'm impressed there is sacredness to go around, even in the secular world.

I once visited a monument to victims of a concentration camp near Minsk. Those were Russian Communist days and there was no reference to anything religious but it was ever more a sacred place. I've also been to Graceland; same deal. There are places and things, values and relationships that are sacred to us. A cemetery reserved for men and women who valued their nation more than their lives is a sacred place. The Founders of our republic "held these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal..." In 1776, they were speaking the truth even when they only meant landed white males. As this powerful idea has been enlarged to understand all means all, the sacredness of it is clearer yet.

We have relationships sacred to us. A relationship that is unreservedly based on unconditional love is a sacred thing. Don't get it? Think about how you feel about kids and grandkids. Get it now? We live in a world where such sacred values, institutions, relationships can be defiled and profaned. Here in Duncan a man is looking at a 500-year prison sentence for exactly that and as Karl Jacobs said, "He probably won't be able to serve out the whole term."

Is anything sacred anymore? Yes, lots of things! But it's important to think of what they are — why they are — sacred to us. Otherwise, we can become careless and defile them. Wendell Berry has written there's only the sacred and the desecrated, defiled. At our best, we embrace what's sacred to us as gifts from the God who is holy above all else, and keep it that way.
