

The Amen Corner

Columbus Day

"New occasions teach new duties, Time makes ancient good uncouth; They must ever up and onward Who would keep abreast of truth."

These are from the beautiful hymn, "Once to Every Man and Nation" by James Russell Lowell. It addresses a hard reality: things change.

Several years ago, there was much anxiety because a timely celebration of Martin Luther King, Jr. would overlap with Robert E. Lee's birthday, a state holiday throughout most of the South. Lots of heartburn over this. I knew some things about Gen. Lee. I knew he directed his army to "furl the flag;" a way of saying "let's move on." Early in that war, he was asked by some ladies what he most looked forward to when peace came. He replied "All the fried chicken, butter, and milk I can eat." Many ex-Confederates turned to politics afterward. The only elective office he would accept was President of the Lexington (VA) Bible Society. He'd be embarrassed any statue of him ever went up in the first place. So it was, I imagined the brouhaha over his birthday. In a sphere where earthly cares and values fall away, I saw Lee and King having a toast. Lee, the Episcopalian with wine, and King, the Baptist with iced tea. Lee would congratulate King on the well-deserved recognition, happy to give way. Now, there's a new one.

On October 12, we're scheduled to 528th celebrate the anniversary of Columbus' discovery of America. That's a sticky one. In fact, it initiated the European explorations and settlement in the Western Hemisphere, even though he had no idea it was here. In fact, Scandinavians had been here many centuries before. In fact, the native population already here considered it already discovered by their ancestors. In biggest fact, Columbus and those who followed inflicted all manner of evil on those they found here. They were exploited, enslaved and eliminated. Thus, we have a movement to Indigenous Peoples' Day. This creates conflict with Italian Americans because Columbus Day is more fitting a celebration of their contribution to our country than some sort of Chef Boyardee Day or something. It's also a conflict for that in us that simply hates change because we see some loss. Let's not. What's the big loss vs the chance to appreciate those who got here first. Either way it's a federal holiday!
