- By action of the Board of Directors on the date set forth below, the Board of Directors

- All district employees and officials who are issued district credit cards must comply
 with the Credit Card Policy, and failure to comply with the policy may result in
 disciplinary action, including revocation of credit card privileges.
- The Board shall monitor and oversee the use of district credit cards to ensure
 compliance with the Credit Card Policy. The General Manager and Treasurer shall also
 be responsible for ensuring that all charges are properly documented and that credit
 card information is secure.
- 4. The Credit Card Policy shall be reviewed and updated by the Board of Directors on an annual basis or as necessary to ensure that it remains current and effective.
- The attached Policy may be incorporated into the District Operation and/or Policy Manual, and the Board Secretary is hereby authorized to assign and revise policy numbers, and format and reformat the attached as needed for an organized, comprehensive Manual.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the individuals listed above are authorized to use the credit cards solely for authorized purchases on behalf of the Irrigation District, and that any unauthorized use of the credit cards shall be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Irrigation District Board shall periodically review the use of credit cards by the authorized individuals and shall take appropriate action to ensure compliance with the credit card policy.

RESOLUTION ORDERING AN ELECTION, REQUESTING COUNTY ELECTIONS TO CONDUCT THE ELECTION, AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF THE ELECTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10002, the governing body of any district may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors of the county to permit the county elections official to render specified services to the district relating to the conduct of an election; and

WHEREAS, the resolution of the governing body of the district shall specify the services requested; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10002, the district shall reimburse the county in full for the services performed upon presentation of a bill to the district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10400, whenever two or more elections, including bond elections, of any legislative or congressional district, public district, city, county, or other political subdivision are called to be held on the same day, in the same territory, or in territory that is in part the same, they may be consolidated upon the order of the governing body or bodies or officers calling the elections; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10400, such election for special districts may be either completely or partially consolidated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10403, whenever an election called be a district or other political subdivision for the submission of any question, proposition, or office to be filled is to be consolidated with a statewide election, and the question, proposition, or office to be filled is to appear upon the same ballot as that provided for that statewide election, the district or other political subdivision shall, at least 88 days prior to the date of the election, file with the board of supervisors, and a copy with the elections official, a resolution of its governing board requesting the consolidation, and setting forth the exact form of any question, proposition, or office to be voted upon at the election, as it is to appear on the ballot. Upon such request, the Board of Supervisors may order the consolidation; and

WHEREAS, the resolution requesting the consolidation shall be adopted and filed at the same time as the adoption of the ordinance, resolution, or order calling the election; and

WHEREAS, various district, county, state and other political subdivision elections may be or have been called to be held on November 7, 2023;
