#### CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

#### Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

**A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED WHEN THE SAME DOG IS BEING ENTERED IN A MIXTURE OF REGULAR AND PREFERRED AND/OR DIFFERENT JUMP HEIGHTS WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL WEEKEND THEREBY CLEARLY INDICATING WHICH CLASS(ES) AND/OR JUMP HEIGHTS BELONG TOGETHER FOR EACH TRIAL DAY OF THE WEEKEND.**

#### PBGVCA IS OFFERING FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

#### Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered,

the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge. Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST course times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

#### Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score..

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

**During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows 50% online and 50% paper. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour period, the club reserves the right to increase or decrease either one accordingly.**

### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Petit Basset Griffon Vendéens fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any

deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

### MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

**NATIONAL CHALLENGE TROPHY**

The PBGVCA National Agility Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the winner of High in Trial at the National Agility Trial. Highest Scoring Dog in Trial is awarded on the basis of the highest score which must be 100. If there is a tie for the highest score, the dog with the most yards per second prevails. Standard run time will be adjusted for the pause table when figuring YPS for High in Trial only.

For permanent possession of the National Agility Challenge Trophy, it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive trials. The owner must be a member in good standing of PBGVCA at the time of the trial.

There will also be a Highest Scoring Dog in Trial award for the Regional Agility Trial with the same requirements to win the award. No challenge trophy offered for the Regional Trial.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen Club of America and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

**Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen Club of America** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen Club of America or any official thereof.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**PBGVCA** agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

**REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

**Since Bitches in season** are not allowed to compete in this trial, PBGVCA will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per trial for bitches unable to compete for this reason. If the bitch is on site, verification must be made by the Trial Chair or

the chair's designee. A veterinarian letter on practice's letterhead will be accepted if submitted no less than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the trial.

### RINGSIDE

**Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

### MOVE-UPS

Move-up requests for Tuesday must be made in writing and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, March 30, 2026, by 8 AM. They may be e-mailed to [earlyagility@gmail.com](mailto:earlyagility@gmail.com). Provide dog's call name, owner's name, original class entered and new class requested.

Move-ups for Trial 2 must include the above information and the dog's AKC number and must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site as soon as feasibly possible after the run that made your dog eligible to move-up.



If using GPS, please use site address (8340 West Harrell Road, Oak Ridge, NC) rather than site name (Rising Star Canine Ranch). From the south: I-77N, take exit 13A onto I-85N toward Greensboro. Take exit 87 onto I-285 toward Winston-Salem. Take exit 107A onto US-311/I-40E toward Greensboro/High Point. Take exit 201 toward Union Cross Road, continue 4mi. Continue on Main St (NC-150) for .6mi, turn right onto N Main St (NC-150) and continue 6mi (turns into Oak Ridge Road). Turn left onto NC-68N for 2.8 miles, turn left onto Haw River Road for 1.5 miles, turn left onto West Harriell Rd. for 1 mile.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
