

## WSDTC AGILITY TRIAL INFORMATION

May 1-3

This trial will be held at Rising Star Canine Ranch, 8340 W. Harrell Rd, Oak Ridge, NC 27310.

### TRIAL SCHEDULE:

#### NO EARLY SET- UP ON THURSDAY

Friday-Sunday, May 1-3

7:00 a.m. - Arena opens

7:30 a.m. - Check-in and measurement.

7:40 a.m. - Judge's briefing and walk-throughs

8:00 a.m. - First dog on the line

Height running order: Friday and Sunday tall to small; Saturday small to tall

All heights will walk together except Master/Excellent Classes. The plan is to use a walk-walk run format, with one-half of the 16" dogs walking with the 4-12" dogs and the other half walking with the 20-24" dogs. We will then run 4-16" dogs or 20-24" dogs depending on the day, then take a 5-minute break to switch out workers. The walk break will be reflected on agility gate.

COURSE MAPS: Will be posted on agility gate as well at the trial site.

### GATE/CHECK-IN

We will use the Agility Gate app for check-in, and the running order will be displayed on monitors. If you are unable to use Agility Gate, the Gate Steward can check you in. To use the app, you will need to download the free app from the Appstore or Google Play.

THE PASS CODE FOR AGILITY GATE IS 8340.

A preliminary running order will be posted no later than April 27, if not sooner. Trial information and an estimated timeline will be posted at [www.earlyagility.com](http://www.earlyagility.com) no later than April 27, if not sooner. This will help you gauge when you will need to be available to walk your course or carry out your volunteer assignment. Please note that this is only an

ESTIMATE and the trial may run considerably faster (or slower), so please allow for this. The timeline and running order do not reflect move-ups.

#### VENDORS

Beverly Adams will provide human and canine massages. Please take care of yourself and your dog by taking advantage of Bev's fabulous massage services.

#### CHECK-IN and MEASURING

We will have two VMOs - Alex Davis and Ben Gibbs. If your dog needs to be measured, please be sure to get this done prior to your first run. Alex and Ben are both competing at this trial, so please take that into account and be courteous. They can measure when they are not walking the course or running their dogs. Please refer to the AKC measuring guidelines at <https://www.akc.org/sports/agility/exhibitor-resources/jump-height-card> to determine if your dog must be measured at the trial.

As a reminder, leashes can be worn or put in pockets - now part of Chapter 4, section 10. This has been effective since January 1, 2022.

Parking in front of the building is for club members who are working the trial, handicapped exhibitors, and people crating out of their car.

PLEASE DO NOT CRATE DOWNSTAIRS OR PARK IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING, UNLESS YOU HAVE A RESERVED SPOT. Sandy Fisher is the parking and crating coordinator for this trial, so please see Sandy if you have any questions. Please be aware that crating downstairs will be tight and we may not be able to allow chairs in the crating area. Please be understanding and work with each other and be nice to Sandy.

#### TRIAL SITE RULES:

- 1, Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) anywhere on the property. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
2. NO SMOKING and NO CHEWING GUM allowed on the property.
3. Please bring 2 pairs of shoes - only CLEAN footwear to be worn on the turf! NO SPIKE SHOES OR HEELS.

4. Any potty accident or mud trails on the turf will warrant a \$20 fine. [Cash or check payable to Rising Star Canine Ranch should be left with the trial secretary]. Special cleaning products will be provided by RSCR.

Light snacks and coffee will be available to volunteers.

PLEASE NOTE: Bottled water WILL NOT be provided. The facility has a filtered water fountain designed for refilling cups and water bottles. PLEASE PLAN TO BRING YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE to refill.

## Directions to the Site:

If using GPS, please use site address (8340 West Harrell Road, Oak Ridge, NC) rather than site name (Rising Star Canine Ranch). From the south: I-77N, take exit 13A onto I-85N toward Greensboro. Take exit 87 onto I-285 toward Winston-Salem. Take exit 107A onto US-311/I-40E toward Greensboro/High Point. Take exit 201 toward Union Cross Road, continue 4mi. Continue on Main St (NC-150) for .6mi, turn right onto N Main St (NC-150) and continue 6mi (turns into Oak Ridge Road). Turn left onto NC-68N for 2.8 miles, turn left onto Haw River Road for 1.5 miles, turn left onto West Harrell Rd. for 1 mile.

## Handlers' Responsibilities:

We will need everyone's cooperation to keep things moving. To make sure that this trial runs as smoothly and efficiently as possible, we will use the following procedures:

1. Please be sure to check in on agility gate. If you have problems with agility gate, the gate steward can help you check in.

2. While each dog is running, we will have one dog on the line, one dog on deck, and one dog in the hole. Be sure that you are at the gate, ready to take your place in line. We will not look for you---if you are not there, you may lose your turn to run. Because this is a two-ring, one judge trial, there should be no conflicts. If you are running two dogs and we haven't given you enough room between your dogs, you may work with the gate steward to move your dogs, but they must stay in the same order as they appear on the gate, in other words, whichever dog is supposed to run first must still run first.

3. The dog on the line should be ready to run before the dog on course finishes the last obstacle. When the timer tells you to go, begin your run!
