


### 02 New World Institute


The Ancient Spanish Monastery Miami, FL 33160




# O3 Chapel of Grace




# 04 Langston Hughes Cultural Center


2015 5th Ave New York, NY 10035







Foundation Plan Second Floor Framing Plan











Ground Floor Plumbing Plan








### 05 Seattle Children's Hospital
