INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

ALERT! Social customs & norms vary from country to country so, before you go abroad, be sure to understand [customs/norms] of the place you are traveling to.

The following are some of the requirements needed for travel abroad.

- Have passport and Visa (check country requirements)
- Consent for travel with minors under 16
- Have required immunizations
- Purchase travel health insurance
- Be familiar with currency and exchange rates
- Get an international driver's license if planning to drive
- Be familiar with the laws of the country
- Enroll in the Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) – enroll trip with nearest U.S. Embassy or Consulate (highly recommended)
- Do not attempt to bring firearms or drugs into the country
- Take extra precautions to remain and keep valuables safe
- Ensure that your point of contact at home is aware of travel plans
- Check with your cell phone provider to determine your coverage plan
