Charges (as at Sept 2025)

Hours not funded by Universal funding (15 hours per week) or working parent/extended funding (a further 15 hours per week) are charged @ £8 per hour. Our fees are reviewed annually.	
Morning session 0900 – 1200	£29.10 (this includes snacks, drinks and lunch £5.10)
Afternoon session 1200 – 1500	£25.00 (this includes snacks and drinks at £1.00)
Full day 0900 – 1500	£54.10 (this includes snacks, drinks and lunch £6.10)
Breakfast Club (0730 – 0900)	£6
Stay & Play Session (1500 – 1800)	£12

Funding for academic year 2025/2026

Two-year-old children of working parents may be eligible for 15 hours funding each week and may also be eligible if you receive the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit
- tax credits and you have an annual income of under £16,190 before tax
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- support through part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

15 hours universal funding is available for all 3 & 4 year olds in the term after they become 3. Many 3 & 4 year olds may also be eligible to claim 30 hours funding. If you believe your child is eligible for funding, you must apply for this online via this link: <https://www.gov.uk/get-free-childcare-if-youre-working> In addition to government funding, you can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year). More information via this link.
