




THE LITTLE LOT NURSERY




Fundraising

Medicines in nursery

Non-prescription medication will **NOT** be administered at the nursery. If your child needs Calpol or similar, they are not well enough to come to nursery.

Any child taking medication, including antibiotics, **must not** return to nursery until the medication has been administered for 48 hours at home to ensure it has begun to take effect and there are no adverse reactions.



Please see a staff member to complete the paperwork if any prescribed medication is to be administered during the Nursery day.
