

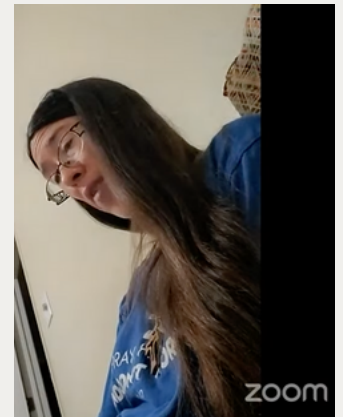
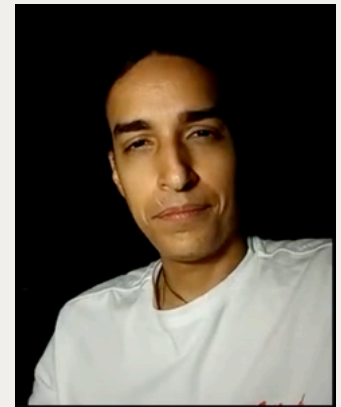
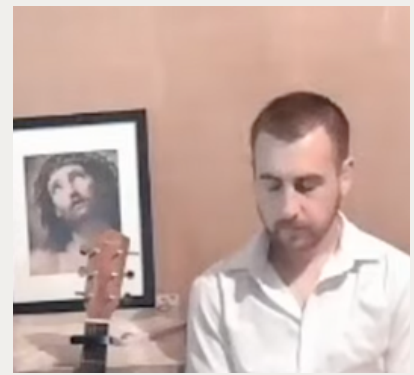

YOUTH ON FIRE

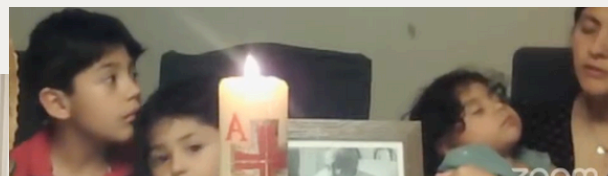

He made it clear to both of us that a very deep prayer life as well as the Divine Will apostolate would be our full time occupation and that He would provide all the money we need for rent and groceries. This would give us the opportunity to put on more internet events like the Prayer Furnace, as well as make more instructional videos and lead cenacles.



I want to add that right after God placed this call on her heart, Cecelia received a text offering her a dream job as a youth minister with security and benefits, something she had wanted for a long time... But she courageously declined the offer and resolved to leave everything behind to follow Jesus into the unknown. We have discerned this inspiration with a priest, who has confirmed it as

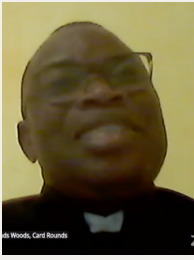
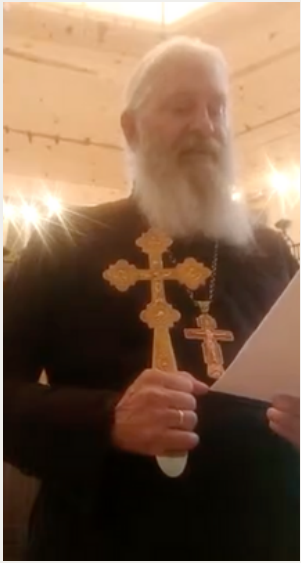

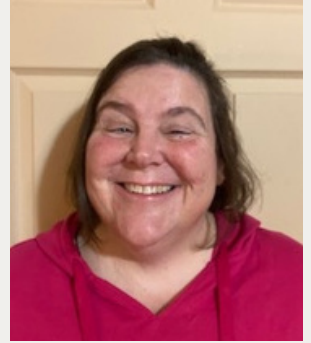


St. Hannibal Di Francia, pray for us!

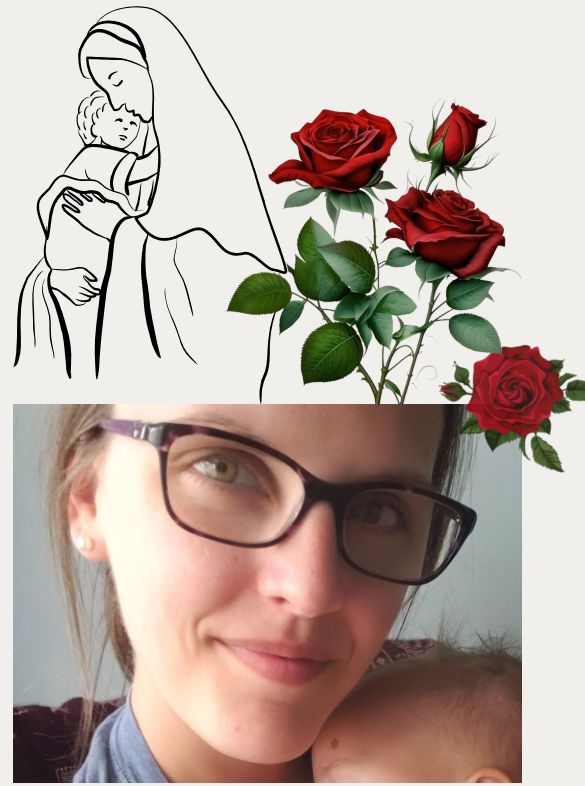
Having attended daily, tuning in as much as possible, was a transforming event in my life. I am able to pray so much better, operating in the DW

“This last week, in the prayer furnace with Youth on Fire, I discovered what it means for eternity to break into time. We prayed, we sang, we sought Him — and suddenly the air was not just air, it was charged with God’s own presence. I could feel His hand upon us, as tangible as the warmth of the sun.

God did not whisper a suggestion, He unveiled a plan — the plan He had written for me before the foundations of the world. And He did so in the company of young men and women who were astonishingly ordinary and astonishingly holy all at once: people with flaws, laughter, and interests, yet burning with a love that is anything but ordinary. To be among them was to realize that Christianity is not an escape from reality, but reality itself made luminous.

The Catholic faith, lived here, was not a set of cold rules; it was a fire, a tradition breathing with life. Prayer was not duty but oxygen. Love was not sentiment but substance. And courage — courage to seek God in every place, at every moment, in every corner of life — was not rare, but radiant.

For the first time, I was not just accepted, but understood — not merely seen, but known. In their company I discovered that holiness is not about being less human, but more: to become, in Christ, fully alive.

“My dad leaving our family for another woman when I was 5 years old forever shattered my self esteem, and robbed me of any intrinsic value that I thought I had as a human being. If my own father didn’t think I was “good enough” or “worthy enough” for him to stay, what lasting hope would I have in anything or anyone else?

I saw myself as one major disappointment. My life, an unfulfilled waste. “I never asked to be born,” I remember thinking. When I would try to improve my situation, to purge myself of the habits I most hated about myself, I would only end up falling deeper into the same addictions where the endless cycles of guilt and shame became a way of life. My life, now tainted by the abandonment of my father, shrouded in depression and clothed in endless insecurities, would be marked by moments and seasons where I would constantly look for a fresh start, a blank slate, that I thought I would find by enrolling at new schools or moving on to new workplaces. Each time, I would attempt to mold myself into the person I thought I should be, in order that those around me might finally deem me worthy, acceptable, likeable - dare I say, loveable - only to fall short every time. Every attempt to fit in, to be liked, to be validated, was met with failure, loneliness and utter disappointment.

After meeting Jesus face to face for the first time in a small room before a monstrance at the age of 19, beautiful as He is and transformational as my conversion of heart was, inwardly, my feelings of unworthiness simply transferred from how I felt the world saw me to how I thought the Lord saw me; I really believed that I had to do something or be something other than the broken, flawed version that I was to be approved and loved by Him. I was always a prisoner to my own thoughts. Try as I might, I was never capable of healing myself with Christ. And it’s only because “I” was never meant to.

After experiencing the prayer furnace (in person!), my relationship with Jesus would be forever changed. It was always Him. He was always meant to heal me with HIS own power, HIS own love, HIS own strength. All along, He has wanted nothing other than my permission, the utter abandonment of my will into His most loving and capable hands. It was here that I discovered that healing is not linear. It was here that I discovered that time alone was never going to be enough to heal all of my wounds. The way I had previously approached my spiritual life was absolutely pulverized and made new in the best way imaginable. When I would finally accept His love for myself, to give Him permission to love me, I would begin to love others in every word, action and thought because of the newfound purity of heart and intention that I had previously lacked. Because it would no longer be me, but He who would now be living in me that would do it. All of it.

I discovered, for the first time, the hidden meaning behind the gospels, behind creation, behind my own existence. And suddenly, it hit me - I was breathed into existence for no other reason than to be loved by Him, that I might one day come to genuinely love Him in return, with His own pure love.

Before the furnace, I was experiencing the world through my own eyes, my own wounds. My own flawed filters. It is only now, thanks to Jesus and His leading me into the knowledge of the Divine Will, that I am finally letting go of who I was. It is because of Youth on Fire that I am now experiencing myself and the world around me through His own eyes, through His own heart. As I continue to allow myself to be enamored by His heart, led by His own understanding, and healed by His own tender grace, I no longer have to strive or wonder about where I stand in His eyes, worry about what or how my healing will look like, or stress about what my future will hold. I can simply trust, love and believe Him when He says He is good, and everything He does is good, and everything He ever has or will allow is good. Because you, Jesus, are the only one true good. You are simply love itself. I love you Jesus. I really, really do.

And so, dear reader, I invite you to completely abandon yourself to His love. Look to the cross. There is no safer place in the universe than within His own Sacred heart. Give Him the nothingness of your human will, that He would give you His own will, His everything, in return. Because it truly is all or nothing, and there is no in-between. Once you give Him permission to take everything, there will be nothing to go back to - for everything means nothing unless it comes through Him.
