



Firefighter Hat Craft – Instructions

Firefighter Hat Craft

This simple and fun paper plate craft allows students to create their own firefighter hat while reinforcing the lesson on community helpers.

Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
 - Scissors
 - Glue
 - White piece of paper
 - Red paint **or** red marker
 - Marker or crayon (for number)
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Directions

1. Cut the center out of the paper plate, leaving the outer rim to create the brim of the hat.
 2. From the remaining center piece, cut a firefighter helmet shape.
 3. Glue the helmet shape onto the paper plate brim.
 4. Paint the hat red or color it using a red marker.
 5. Cut a small shield shape from white paper and glue it onto the front of the hat.
 6. Write a number or badge symbol on the shield (optional).
 7. Allow the craft to dry before wearing.
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Learning Connection

As students create their firefighter hats, discuss how firefighters help the community and keep people safe. Encourage students to share something they learned or say “thank you” to firefighters.

Teacher Tip

No paint? Red markers or crayons work just as well!
