 - 1. **September 18 Q3 Meeting/Clean Up** no quorum, focused on the drainage behind baseball field
 - (Q4)
 - 2. October 16 Trail Work Day volunteers from the neighborhood and Community Bucket - and led by Nichole Weiswasser - packed and slung 6 tons of slate trail mix and fixed up the landscaping stairs going down to the trails behind the baseball field
 - 3. October 17 Donuts & Coffee celebrated improvements in the park installing benches and bike racks, resurfacing tennis court, and fixing landscaping stairs

- 4. **November 5-6 Plantlanta** Trees Atlanta volunteers sawed up fallen branches, removed chaff flower by the fallen oak and did some trail widening work. Planted new trees, especially in the area cleared by the white oak and to improve erosion on front slope.
- 5. November 20 Q4 Park Work Day (& Social at Red's Beer Garden)
 - a) Nichole W led stair touch up of landscaping stairs
 - b) Jacob M & Taryn A led sawing up fallen trees blocking the paths around the fallen white oak and path widening/mulching trails
 - c) Lan & Annette led kudzu removal/tree rescue at bottom of landscaping stairs
 - d) Amanda led plantings revitalizing front slope according to our landscaping plan from Samantha Spitale ferns, hydrangeas
- B. Project updates
 - 1. Bike racks & benches done!
 - 2. Gault Street Entrance & Unity Bridge
 - a) Survey of 14.5 acres complete as of 11/1 available on focwp.org! Thank you Empire Communities.
 - b) Conceptual plan Empire paid \$3.5k for a conceptual plan. We received a budget for that plan, which shows that erosion in the park is major obstacle for our goals (see graphic).

 - Withdrew from Park Pride grant consideration for 2022 (will apply for another small change grant this year -- likely drainage issue around tennis court)
 - (2) Working on getting a second opinion Patrick Hand
 - (3) Scheduled meetings with City officials and actively seeking funding options - infrastructure bond, developers, Watershed

- (4) Work on real budget numbers Stream Bank Erosion and Hazard Index report - \$5,600. Work started Nov. 17. Empire paid \$2,800, CDC paid \$1,400, Loose Nuts Cycles paid \$1,400.
