

- Meeting called to order at 0937
- Meeting minutes been approved at 0938, no objections
- Taryn gave updates per agenda
  - Positive reactions from the neighborhood about Trees Atlanta recognition
  - Trying to get all players in the neighborhood including councilperson, developments, etc. to try to talk about the need for connectivity
  - Public vote for infrastructure bond in May (this includes our entrance, playground, etc.) Stay tuned. The exec committee is keeping close tabs on that.

- Drainage project: Do we want to try to make this a bigger project? Or just regrade, add rocks, etc.
  - Concerns = maintenance, our plants getting mowed, etc.
  - We could maybe start smaller, regrade + river rock for swale, and see how it holds up. Revisit for plantings, etc.
- Executive Committee is very excited about using sheep to try to clear some invasives in the area.
  - Taryn has put together a presentation to talk about our 3 priorities: invasive removal, revive bbq/picnic areas, and work on improving drainage.
  - Taryn has relayed community feedback to the shepherd and the shepherd will ultimately decide if it's safe and feasible for sheep to be here.
    - Concerns are stray dogs, coyotes, etc. We've used goats in the past with guard dogs and had some success.
- Re-invigorating the picnic area with slate chips and using Empire's tree cuttings to make picnic areas more cozy. Bobbie to send some ideas. We should consider any maintenance concerns
- Ideas for park amenities?
  - Soccer is always there. Lines might move around or be too restrictive. Maybe lights to help with safety and to be accommodating of more varieties of sports.
  - Make sure they aren't too bright for neighbors. They could be timed to park hours.
