Voted Neighborhood of the Year by Trees Atlanta

- 1. **December 18, 2021, Q4 Membership Meeting** approved budget, elected executive committee.
- February 27, 2022, Q1 Work Day volunteers from the neighborhood unearthed the hidden stairs below the playground, widened nature trails, removed ivy from near the tennis court, and planted native grasses and ground cover on the front slope.
- 3. **Trees Atlanta** continues to remove invasives in the park every third Friday of the month and work on trail widening.
- 4. **Community FoodScapes** removed ivy from 100 trees near the baseball field with a volunteer group of 30 in February.
- B. Project updates

- Tennis Court drainage found drain inlet. We now need to decide
 whether to complete full rain garden plan designed by Bishop Davis or
 simply regrade with a swale and add some river rock. It may depend what
 the City prefers.
- 2. **Picnic areas from 1981 site plan** as a maintenance project we will remove ivy from these areas and about 6-8 inches of soil, roots, and leaf litter. Refer to "1981 site plan" doc under "meeting materials" on focwp.org/agendasandminutes
 - a) Taryn has coordinated with House Proud and Atlanta Federal Reserve to get a group of 30 volunteers on April 2.
 - b) FoCP exec committee is looking into partnering with Clyde Shepard Nature Preserve/Applied Community Ecology & City Sheep to bring about 16 sheep to help remove the ivy first.

3. Gault Street Entrance & Unity Bridge

- a) Survey of 14.5 acres complete as of 11/1 available on focwp.org! Thank you Empire Communities.
- b) Conceptual plan Empire paid \$3.5k for a conceptual plan. We received a budget for that plan, which shows that erosion in the park is major obstacle for our goals (see graphic).

- 4. Front slope revitalization \$1,000
 - a) Planted native ground cover and plants \$500 (partnered with Trees Atlanta)
 - b) Still need to buy and plant viburnum, sweetspire, more ferns
 - c) Mulch & weed

- a) New playground is also on infrastructure bond list. We will bring it up at meeting with Parks Commissioner & Jason Winston and ask to be involved in the design.
- b) Looking for ideas about how to get this playground pressure washed and possibly repainted in the meantime.
