Step 1:

Start with an 11" x 8½" piece of cardstock in the color of your choice. Use the Layout and Measurements Template (page 3) to cut and score the cardstock as shown.

Step 2:

Do not trim off the white border — it's needed to follow the template measurements accurately. Use the "Layout and Measurements Template" to cut the collage sheet into sections. Once each section is cut, you can then trim each piece to fit your project as needed. Watch the video to see how I worked through placement challenges, such as upside-down wording or choosing which side of a piece to feature, depending on preference.

Once you've selected, trimmed, corner rounded or angled your pieces, you can distress the edges with the ink of your choice (if desired), then glue them in place.

Ways to use the Rose in Paris Sayings sheet: you can print out on cardstock of your choice or print on paper and distress with ink of your choice. You can tear or cut them out and use glue to adhere to your projects.

> Book 5" tall by 6" wide Score at 3" Finished size 5" tall by 3" wide

> > 6" tall by 11/2" wide

Bookmark

Tag for Pocket Tag 4½" tall by 2" wide

over 41/2" tall by 1" wide

Left

Pocket (Wide or Tall) 4½" tall by 3" wide Score ½" on 3 sides

Pocket Tag 11" tall by 21/2" wide Score at 5½" Finished size 5½" tall by $2\frac{1}{2}$ wide

Fold should be at bottom of tag. Glue at side and top
