

ORDINANCE NO. A-567

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF NEWARK ON MAY 3, 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 4, COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 5, AND MAYOR; DECLARING THE RESULTS OF SAID ELECTION; AND ORDAINING OTHER MATTERS ON THE SUBJECT; PROVIDING REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Newark, Texas ("City Council") ordered and called a General Election ("Election") to be held on Saturday, May 3, 2025 for the purpose of ELECTING Councilmember Place 4, Councilmember Place 5, and Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the said Election of the City of Newark, Texas ("City"), was held in designated and published locations across Wise County on May 3, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has caused to be posted and published in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas, notices of the Election; and

WHEREAS, notices of the Election were actually given by the City and the Wise County Elections Administrator as required by state law; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary presented affidavits of posting and publication of the notices of the Election; and

WHEREAS, the affidavits of posting the publishing notices of the Election were examined and approved; and

WHEREAS, the Election was duly and legally held on May 3, 2025 in the City and in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of the Election, including the early voting results, have been certified and returned by the proper election judges and clerks thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary, acting as special custodian of the election records, presented the canvass report for the Election, including the returns of the early ballots cast in connection therewith, to the Canvassing Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, acting in its capacity as the Canvassing Board for the Election, has considered the returns of said Election, including the returns of said ballots cast in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the Election, including the returns of early ballots cast in connection therewith, duly and legally made, showed that there were cast at said Election, the following total valid and legal votes:

WHEREAS, the City Council, at a Special Council Meeting on May 12, 2025, canvassed the returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code provides that each local canvassing authority shall convene not earlier than the third (3rd) day or later than the eleventh (11th) day after election day for the purpose of canvassing the election results; and

WHEREAS, section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code also provides that only two members of City Council are needed and constitute a quorum for the purpose of canvassing election results; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, at a Special Council Meeting on May 12, 2025, canvassed the returns of said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Incorporation of Premises. The above and foregoing premises are true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. Confirmation of Vote Tabulations. The results of the Election, as canvassed and tabulated above reflect the expressed desires of the resident qualified voters of the City.

SECTION 3. Issuance of Certificate of Election. That the presiding officer of the local canvassing authority is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver a Certificate of Election to the successful candidates elected at the Election.

SECTION 4. Issuance of Canvass of Special Election. The presiding officer of the local canvassing authority is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Canvass of the Election, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas, and to take all other action necessary connection therewith.

SECTION 5. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Article 551.041, Texas Government Code.

SECTION 6. Severability Clause. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Newark hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 7. Repealer Clause. That any provision of any prior ordinance of the City whether codified or uncoded, which are in conflict with any provision of the Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict, but all provisions of the ordinances of the City whether codified or uncoded, which are not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
