The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

Mayor Brandley announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present: Walters, Valianti and Lehman. Councilman Angelucci was not present. Council President Cairns and Councilwoman MacGregor were not present.

Council went over the Engineer's report with Borough Engineer Greg Fusco

Motion to open the meeting to the public by Councilman Lehman, seconded by Councilman Angelucci. All in favor- motion carried.

Ameke Fitzgerald-236 Manheim Ave.-Would like to donate a tree to be planted in VFW Park in memory of her daughter. Mayor and Council all agreed that a tree could be planted. Superintendent of Public Works, Rick Hawco, will meet her and Councilman Lehman at the park tomorrow to go over the planting of the tree.

Liane Hasner-16 Newton Ave.-The Green Team and the Girl Scouts would like to plant a pollinator garden near the former swim club. Mayor and Council all agreed that the garden can be planted.

Being there was no further discussion, motion to close the meeting to the public by Councilman Lehman, seconded by Councilman Angelucci. All in favor; motion carried.

Council went over the tentative agenda for the Council Meeting.

Discussion Items:

Amending Chapter 110 and Chapter 86-Council discussed amending Chapter 110 regarding inoperable vehicles. The ordinance change will have a first reading at the Council meeting. Discussion was also had as to amending Chapter 86 regarding smoking. The ordinance change will also have a first reading at the Council meeting next week.

Recreational Marijuana Ordinances-Council discussed an ordinance for recreational marijuana. More information is needed so this will be continued next month.
