The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

Mayor Brandley announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present: Walters, Angelucci, MacGregor, Valianti and Lehman. Council President Cairns was not present.

Council went over the Engineer's report with Borough Engineer Anthony LaRosa.

RESOLUTION #111-20-AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE MUNICIPAL AND COUNTY AGENCY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND PROGRAM REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT-to approve the agreement with the County of Camden for the Coronavirus Relief Fund Program.

The forgoing resolution was approved by motion of Councilman Lehman, seconded by Councilman Angelucci. Unanimous roll call vote.

Council went over the tentative agenda for the Council Meeting.

Discussion Items:

Proposal-1210 White Horse Pike-a proposal was received from Dave Aron of Aron Movers for the property. Will set up a meeting with the Mayor and Borough Attorney so they can go over the proposal.

Memo from the Planning Board-Council discussed a memo from the Planning Board regarding Ordinance 125-62, Restoration. It was decided that Council agreed with the planning board's recommendation and the ordinance should be amended. Will have a first reading at the Council meeting on the 14th of July.

Request to use Veteran's Park-James Hardy submitted a request to use Veteran's Memorial Park on October 30th, 2020. He submitted a "Hold Harmless Agreement". All council agreed so a resolution will be placed on the Council meeting agenda.

Council gave brief Departments updates.

Motion to open the meeting to the public by Councilman Lehman, seconded by Councilman Angelucci. All in favor- motion carried.

Lou Monoyios-103 Johnson Ave-Asked if the contractor doing the sewer project notifies residents in advance when work on their street is going to be done. Borough Engineer Anthony LaRosa said that yes, the contract will notify twenty-four hours in advance.

Bill Staubs-5 E. Haddon Ave.-As a resident that lives in the construction area, all in all the sewer construction has been going well. Seems to be taking a long time but will be happy when it is done.

Paula Yudkowitz-57 Kendall Blvd.-Concerned with the constant fireworks that have been going off every night. They effect people and pets in many ways. Councilman Walters encouraged Ms. Yudkowitz and all residents to call the police when this is going on.

Pete Mohan-164 E. Bettelwood Ave.-Thank you to the Mayor for his daily updates. Suggested that the Mayor also encourage residents to wear masks. People seem to be very casual about the ask wearing lately. Mayor Brandley thanked Mr. Mohan for his suggestion.

Being there was no discussion, motion to close the meeting to the public by Councilman Walters, seconded by Councilman Lehman. All in favor; motion carried.

Being no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned by motion of Councilwoman Cairns, seconded by Councilman Lehman. All in favor; motion carried.
