The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

Mayor Brandley announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present: Walters, Valianti, MacGregor, Angelucci, Lehman and Cairns.

The minutes of the March 10, 2020 Council Meeting and the April 6, 2020 Caucus Meeting were approved by motion of Councilman Lehman, seconded by Councilman Angelucci. All in favor-motion carried.

Treasurer's Report was not available at the time of the meeting.

Other Financial reports were approved by motion of Councilman Lehman, seconded by Councilman Angelucci. Unanimous roll call vote.

Lou Monyious-103 Johnson Ave-Asked if there was any Redevelopment update. Mayor Brandley replied that he has nothing new to report at this time. There was a report that the State approved the Funding for the Dredging of Newton Creek but it has not gone out to bid yet.

Being there was no further discussion, the meeting was closed to the public by motion of Councilman Lehman, seconded by Council President Cairns. All in favor-motion carried.
